



STEVE STILES studied at the High School of Music & Art and School of Visual Arts in Manhattan. His first fanzine cartoon appeared in <i>Cry of the Nameless.</i> His first professional sale was a cartoon for Paul Krassner's <i>The Realist</i> in 1961. Stiles has won five Fan Activity Achievement (FAAn) Awards for best artist (2001, 2003–2006). In 1998, Stiles won the first Bill Rotsler Award, named after fan artist Bill Rotsler. He is a frequent Best Fan Artist Hugo Award nominee.	HOWARD WALDROP 's first professional sale was "Lunchbox" (<i>Analog</i> , May 1972). His unique fiction has been consistently nominated for the Nebula, Hugo, and World Fantasy Awards. Waldrop's stories combine elements of alternate history, American popular culture, the American South, old movies, character actors, classical mythology, and rock 'n' roll. [SPOILER] His Nebula-winning story, "The Ugly Chickens," inspired Capclave to choose a dodo as our mascot.
