Useful notes.

- The grid does not have eqal spaces for time, each row has a starting time and all items at that ime are shown on that row.
- 2. Most items are an hour. Book signings are 45 minutes. Some things are much longer. Those are shown with a grey bar extending down with the number of minutes at the top. The length very roughly indicates the time. Use the numbers.
- 3. Each double page spread covers the full spread at any time.


