There will be a First Fandom meeting on Saturday in Room 1103. Please contact Art Saha for further details.

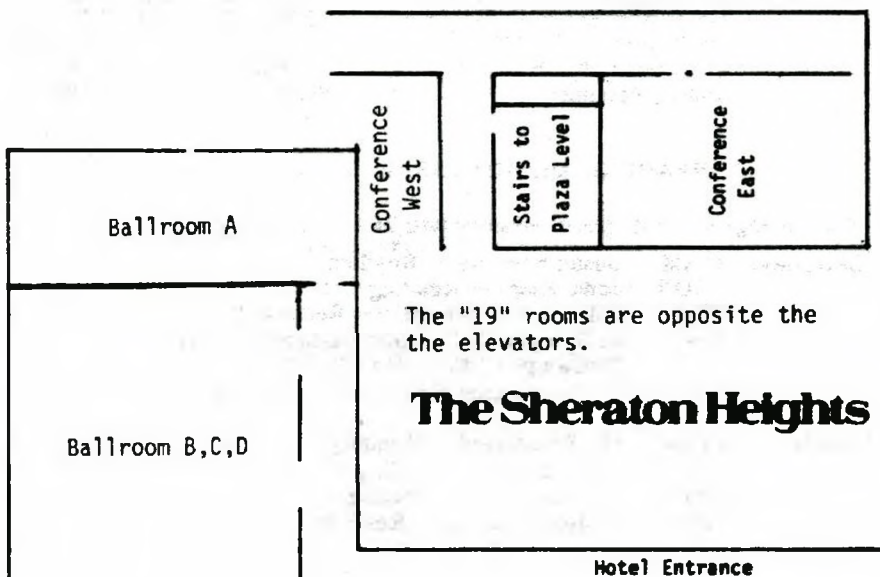
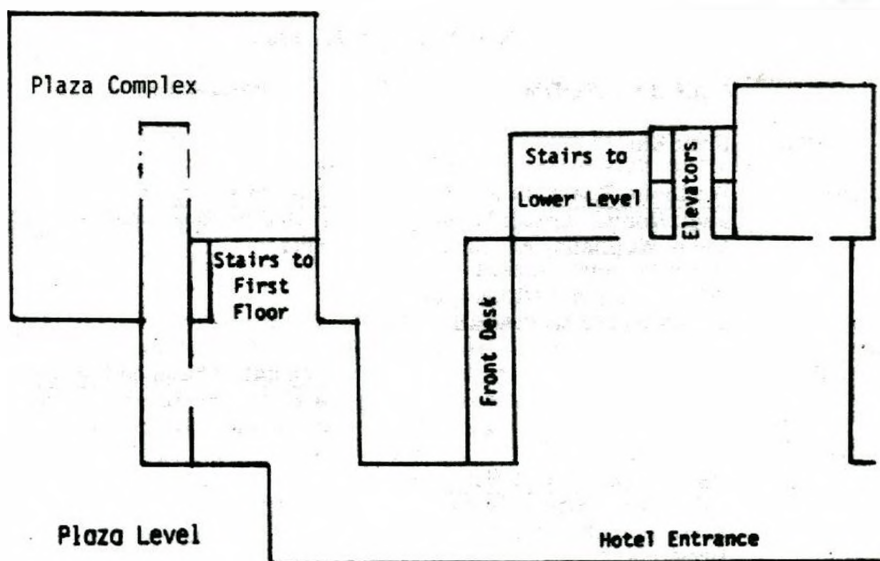
The hotel pool and health club is open Friday and Saturday from 10AM until 11PM.
