ORYCON '86 ART SHOW BUYER'S RULES AND RELEASE

- 1. Purchase of art at the OryCon '86 Art Show or Art Auction includes resale rights but DOES NOT include reproduction rights, unless the artist specifically states otherwise in writing.
- 2. To bid, after having turned in the signed Release, fill in your name, badge number and bid amount on the Bid Sheet attached to the piece. Have an artist or one of the Art Show people initial your bid.
- 3. If your's is the only bid on a piece when the doors close in preporation for the Art Auction on Sunday, you bought it. Pieces with 2 or more bids will go to the Art Auction.
- 4. Artwork with a quick-sale price may be purchased at that price until there is a bid on it. To buy a piece at the quick-sale price, take the Bid Sheet to the Art Show desk (do NOT take down any piece of artwork!) and pay for it. The Art Show worker will give you one copy with your name and badge number and the sale price on it as a receipt. You MUST have that receipt to claim the artwork on Sunday.
- 5. Pieces on the Prints & Sketches tables may be taken at the time of purchase. Take the piece to the Art Show desk and pay on your way out. (Be sure to get your receipt to show as you leave with it.)
- 6. Quick-sale and single-bid purchases may be picked up between 12:30 and 6:30pm on Sunday.
 - A. Single-bid pieces not picked up by 6:30 Sunday will be returned to the artist.
 - B. Unless arrangements are made IN ADVANCE to pick up the work at a later time, quick-sale purchases not claimed by 6:30pm on Sunday will be mailed <u>C.O.D.</u> to the purchaser at the address on the OryCon '86 files. Anything returned by the Post Office becomes the property of OryCon.
 - C. If you cannot pick up the artwork within that time-frame and want someone to pick it up for you, give that person a written release authorizing the OryCon '86 Art Show worker to let your friend take it. Suggested form:

This authorizes ___ (name & badge #) to pick up the art I have purchased, &/or to buy, for me, the art on which I have the only bid.

Signature (name & badge # in block letters)

Be sure to give your friend the receipts for all of your quick-sale purchases.

NOONE OTHER THAN THE PURCHASER MAY PICK UP QUICK-SALE PURCHASES, OR PURCHASE ONE-BID ITEMS, WITHOUT A WRITTEN AUTHORIZATION. It will be that person's responsibility to see to it that <u>all</u> such work is picked up.

- 7. Artwork that was not bid on and has a quick-sale price may be purchased at the quick-sale price by people who come in to pick up other quick-sale or one-bid purchases.
- 8. The number of people in the Art Show room at any one time between 12:30 and 6:30 pm on Sunday may be limited. This will be determined by the number of Art Show workers available to help purchasers and artists. We will do our best to keep things running smoothly. It is a long weekend so be patient with us and we will be patient with you.
- 9. The Sunday referred to in the above sections is Sunday, November 9, 1986, for anyone who feels that "Sunday" wasn't sufficiently clear.
