



## **Restaurant and Services Guide**

Welcome to Hayden Island, in the Columbia River. Any restaurant or store on the island is within walking distance for most (under 1/2 mile), but walk carefully; it's tricky for both pedestrians and cars. People with children might want to drive to island locations for safety's sake.

The only roadway to the mainland is I-5. Vancouver is immediately to the north. It's very accessible, but unlike Vancouver BC we just don't know many good places to eat there. Three options are listed below.

Downtown Portland is 7 miles south on I-5—accessible, but not exactly handy. If you know any good restaurants along that northern corridor, I want to hear about them! Anyone short for time should stay on the island. If you're the kind of person who values good phad thai over good masquerade seating, drop by the Fanzine Room for a look at the Portland Oregonian and Willamette Week restaurant guides (hot off the presses, and with comments in the margins from ye ed.).

We recommend that you make reservations for any restaurant that isn't fast-food, pizza, or a Denny's clone, especially if you have a large group. Phone numbers are all local Oregon numbers unless specified.

Listings are grouped as follows: The hotel; the mall; other places west of I-5 on the island; places east of I-5; Vancouver; and "services" —bank, groceries, etc. Numbers in the margin refer to the area map on page 37.

#### In the Red Lion

Right here in the hotel, we have:

#### Brickstones Bar

Mon-Fri 11:30-Midnight, Sat-Sun 11:30-1:30

A significant food menu is available in the bar from 11:30 to 5, and seating may be available there when Brickstones is backlogged. The abundance of tv screens can make it hard for any but the most iron-willed to carry on a conversation.

#### **Brickstones Restaurant**

Lunch: Mon-Fri 11:30-2:00; Brunch: Sun 8:00-1:30;

Dinner: Fri-Sat 5-11, Sun-Thurs 5-10.

Service can be slow (what else is new?) and prices spendy for fannish wallets, but the food is good. If the grilled lamb salad is still on the menu, I'll be there in a shot. We suggest making reservations. Sunday brunch (8:00-1:30) is \$10 for the buffet, and you can add items from the menu.

#### Red Lion Coffee Garden

The coffee shop is the ideal place to see and be seen (one reason why committee members often eat in the bar). They have agreed to stay open extended hours—6am to midnight Friday and Saturday; 6 am to 11 pm Sunday—but I wouldn't hold my breath.... In case of emergencies, remember, Denny's never closes.

#### **Jantzen Beach Mall**

All the establishments listed for Jantzen Beach Mall are open during standard mall hours: Monday-Friday 10-9; Saturday 10-6; Sunday 11-6.

Good basic Chinese food. I love the dry-sauteed string beans. Take I-5 north to exit 1D, left on Fourth Plain Blvd., left on Main Street at the light, it's a couple blocks down on the left. To come home, take Broadway (behind the restaurant) back to Fourth Plain. Turn right and get into the *left* lane to get back onto I-5. Be prepared to immediately merge left lotsa lanes. It's simple. Honest.


