Yoshitaka Amano - *The Sandman: The Dream Hunters* - Related Book

Moving fluidly from medium to medium and style to style, Yoshitaka Amano has established himself as one of Japan's premier and most popular artists. As a member of the venerable animation company Tatsunoko Studios, Amano created memorable characters such as *G-Force* and *Hutch the HoneyBee*. He has also published over 17 illustrated fantasy books. His work appeared in the interactive role-playing game series *Final Fantasy*. In 1977, he collaborated with the L.A. Philharmonic to create 1,001 Nights an animated film/music project. *The Sandman* is Amano's American comics debut.
