ASFA · CHESLEY · AWARDS SUGGESTED · NOMINATIONS · 1991

This is the nomination suggestions form for the sixth annual ASFA awards, the "Chesleys". The Chesleys, named for the great astronomical artist, Chesley Bonestell, were started in 1985 as a means for the SF and Fantasy art community to recognize individual works and achievements during a given year. The 1991 awards are for works and achievements in the period from January 1 to December 31, 1991. Please do not nominate works from previous years

You MUST be an ASFA member to nominate; but works and achievements by non-members are eligible for the awards. You may xerox and use this form as many times during the year as you like. You may nominate one or many work(s) at a time. But you can only nominate a particular work ONCE. If you as an individual nominate a particular work more than once, the committee may be forced to invalidate your nominations.

To assist us in the identification of the nominated works, please list the artist's name and the title of the work. If the work is a book or magazine cover, please indicate the title of the book, author's name and the publisher as well. In the case of 3-d work, if known, please indicate the medium of the work (for example, glass or bronze). Nominations must be for specific works with the exception of the AWARD FOR ARTISTIC ACHIEVEMENT which represents an artist's body of work. You may nominate up to five works for each category.

The award for BEST ART DIRECTOR recognizes outstanding overall art direction during the entire year. It is not an award for a specific book or magazine.

Please note the year and the place you have seen the work(s) you are nominating: (for example, CHICON V Art show or Silicon '91). Please give
us your name, address and phone number as well, so that if we have trouble locating an artist, we can ask you for more details. If already known, please supply us with the name, address, and phone number of the artist of the nominated work(s).
