1994 HUGO AND CAMPBELL AWARD WINNERS

ConAdian, the 52nd World Science Fiction Convention, held Labor Day weekend in Winnipeg, Manitoba, has presented the annual Hugo Awards for Achievement in Science Fiction and Fantasy, and the John W. Campbell Award for Best New Writer.

The winners are:

Best Non-Fiction Book: The Encyclopedia of Science Fiction, edited by John Clute and Peter Nicholls (Orbit; St. Martin's)

Best Dramatic Presentation: <u>Jurassic Park</u> (Universal; Produced by Kathleen Kennedy & Gerald R. Malen; Directed by Steven Spielberg; Screenwriters, Michael Crichton & David Koepp)

There were 491 valid ballots received.

The World Science Fiction Society Constitution requires that the number of ballots preferring No Award to the leading candidate be compared to the number preferring the leading candidate to No Award. If the former number is greater then No Award shall be declared the winner. This eventuality did not come to pass. The relevant statistics follow. For each category, column A lists the number of voters who ranked No Award higher than the actual winner, column B those who ranked No Award but did not list the actual winner, and column C the total of the first two. Column D lists those who ranked the winner higher than No Award, column E those who ranked the winner but did not list No Award, and column F the total of the previous two.
