

## 1983 Site-Selection Ballot & Voting Instructions

1. Fill in the information requested on the other side of this form. You should give the address that you want the winning bidder to have in their files for your convention membership. Your Denvention II membership number isn't required, but including it will save us a little work. If you are not already a Denvention II member, you must enclose an additional \$15.00 (US) with your ballot to join as a supporting member (or \$45.00 (US) to become an attending member), in addition to the voting fee. Checks for Denvention II membership should be made payable to "Denvention II"; the deadline for new Denvention II memberships is 15 July 1981.
2. **You must include a voting fee of \$7.50 (US) or equivalent with this ballot.** Checks for the bidding fee should be made payable to "The 41st World Science Fiction Convention". The \$7.50 will make you a supporting member of the 1983 Worldcon, regardless of who wins. The WSFS constitution provides that you can convert to attending membership in the winning convention within 90 days after Denvention II for no more than an additional \$7.50.
3. Either (A) mail this ballot to **Denvention II, Site Selection, Box 11545, Denver, CO 80211 USA** by 15 August 1981 (15 July if you are not already a Denvention II member), or (B) bring it to Denvention II and hand it in at the site-selection table before voting closes at 6pm Saturday, 5 September 1981.
4. Indicate your vote preferentially below. You should put a "1" by your first choice for the 1983 Worldcon site, a "2" by your second choice, etc. If your first-place choice is eliminated, your ballot will be counted for your second-place choice; if that is also eliminated, for your third-place choice; etc. If you vote first for "**No Preference**", or if all those you vote for ahead of it are eliminated, your ballot will have no further effect in choosing the 1983 site. "**None of the Above**" is treated just like a real candidate, except that if it wins, the site-selection decision will be made by the WSFS business meeting at Denvention II. If you put some mark next to only one bidder and nothing by the others, you will be counted as having voted for that bidder in first place; if that bidder is eliminated, your ballot will have no further effect on the site selection.

Make checks payable to Denvention II.**)*

**Mail this ballot with your \$7.50 voting fee (made payable to "The 41st World Science Fiction Convention") to Denvention II, Site Selection, Box 11545, Denver, CO 80211 USA, in time for it to arrive by August 15, 1981 (July 15, 1981 if it contains a Denvention II membership application).**

or

**Turn in this ballot with your \$7.50 voting fee at the Site Selection Voting table at Denvention II before 6pm Saturday, September 5, 1981.**

**Note:** The WSFS Constitution provides that a bidding committee must provide on request to any member of Denvention II a written copy of the rules under which their convention committee will operate (including a specification of the term of office of their chief executive officer and the conditions and procedures for the selection and replacement of such officer).
