

IGUANACON PROGRESS REPORT 4.5
Last-minute Corrections and Additions to PR 4

As with any large-scale operation, there are bound to be errors and omissions made in the production of a Worldcon Progress Report. Such is the case with PR 4, so it behooves the committee to try to correct some of our glitches.

- 1) Ken and Lou Moore are running the artshow. The omission of their names in the list of committee members was in error.
- 2) Michael Moorcock has requested that his name be removed from consideration for the Gandalf Grand Master award. His name has been removed from the ballot, but not the PR. This is in error.
- 3) The committee has decided to drop plans for Genre Luncheons, as there are simply too many attendant hassles involved. This does not apply to independently run functions such as the Burroughs Dum-dum.
- 4) Larry Smith and Ross Pavlac are no longer in charge of Convention Services. Their job has been reassigned to Rusty Hevelin.
- 5) A clarification of our hotel reservation policy: PLEASE don't send any deposit money to Iguanacon. Sure, we can use the extra cash, but if you send it to us it won't do your room reservation any good. If you do mail a deposit, send it, with your reservation card or confirmation or whatever, to the hotel at which you plan to stay.
- 6) There is a possibility that we might maybe perhaps (Like the way we're committing ourselves?) put out a fifth progress report. If we do, it will be a one-sheet affair along the lines of the original Iguanacon Bulletin.
- 7) ARIZONA LIQUOR LAWS (just the thing you wanted to hear about...!): The minimum age required to buy alcoholic beverages here is 19. There are no restrictions as to what kind of liquor anyone this age or older may buy. Bars and liquor stores remain open until 1 AM every night, and on Sundays they do not open until Noon.
- 8) WHEN PEOPLE GET INTO TOWN: The hotels are located just two blocks from the local bus terminals; easy walking distance if you do not have very much luggage. The airport is six miles from the hotels, and limousine service is available, for a price, between the terminals and the hotels. Also, the city busses run between the two locations, but they are not as frequent or as reliable. Those of you who are driving to phoenix: I have been asked to tell you that locally gasoline costs on the order of 60¢ per gallon.
- 9) CHECKING INTO THE HOTELS: Before you can get your room, you will need to present a major credit card, or else have one night's rent on deposit. People bringing pets: please mention this when you make reservations; you will be placed in the Ramada Inn located 3 blocks from the ~~main~~ hotels.
- 10) BABYSITTING: the hotels will have a babysitting service available.
