Ballot to Select the 57th World Science Fiction Convention

This is the ballot to select the 57th WorldCon to be held in 1999. Each voter will become a supporting member of the 57th WorldCon.

Rules:

- 1. To be eligible to vote, you must be a living, natural person and either an attending or supporting member of L.A.con III. Ballots cast for memberships held by non-natural persons, such as 'Guest of' memberships, Clubs, Toys, etc. may only be voted as No Preference.
- If you are not a member of L.A.con III, and wish to vote by mail, you may become a supporting or attending member on the ballot by sending a <u>Separate Check</u> for the appropriate fee made out to: L.A.con III. <u>Do not mail cash.</u>
- 3. Your ballot must be accompanied by the voting fee: US\$35. Checks should be made out to: the 57th World Science Fiction Convention, or the 57th WorldCon.
- 4. Ballots may be cast either by mail or in person at L.A.con III. Ballots should be mailed to the Site Selection Administrator. The postmark deadline for Mail-In ballots is July 31, 1996. Balloting at L.A.con III will close Saturday August 31, 1996 at 6:00 p.m. PDT

- 5. Voting: Site Selection ballots are tallied by preferential balloting procedures. The winner is the first bid to get a majority of those ballots expressing a preference. This means that you should indicate your favorite selection with a "1", your next favorite with a "2", etc.
- After filling out the ballot, fold the bottom edge up to the gray line below these instructions, and tape it closed to conceal your vote from casual viewing before the count.
- 7. All ballots must have the voter's name, address and be signed. In addition to being used to validate the ballot, this information will be passed on to the winning bid, so they know who their members are.
