

TWENTY THIRD WORLD SCIENCE FICTION CONVENTION.....LONDON, 1965

HUGO NOMINATION FORM

This is the nomination form for the 1965 Hugo Awards in the categories listed below. The period of eligibility is from January 1st to December 31st, 1964. Anyone can nominate items for the awards. From these nominations the Convention Committee will draft the final voting form. Only members of the convention will be allowed to vote in the final voting. For the purposes of this form the term "science fiction" includes items normally classified as fantasy.

BEST NOVEL: comprising any science fiction hardcover or paperback novel or magazine serial of two or more parts in successive issues of a magazine. Give title, author, publisher and date.

BEST SHORT STORY: comprising any science fiction story not covered by the Best Novel category. Give title, author, magazine issue or other relevant data.

BEST MAGAZINE: comprising any professionally published science fiction magazine.

BEST FANZINE: comprising any amateur published magazine generally considered to fall within the field of science fiction fandom. Give details of such work if possible.

BEST PUBLISHER: comprising any publisher publishing science fiction during the period.

Nominations must arrive not later than March 31st 1965. Please ensure that full details are enclosed for each nomination (including the identification of the nominator) - proof of eligibility is your responsibility. In the event of any dispute the Committee's decision is final.
