What is a Worldcon Bid? Future Worldcon sites are decided three years in advance by current Worldcon members. So the 1997 convention site will be voted on by the membership of the 1994 con, Conadian in Winnipeg. Groups wanting to host a Worldcon compete by bidding, convincing potential voters that they have what it takes. The major visible portion of this procedure is the Bid Party, thrown at other conventions to promote their con and city.

The LoneStarCon bid committee has picked San Antonio to host the first Worldcon ever held in Texas. The city has major benefits:

**The Convention Center:** Located downtown, the Convention Center boasts two halls (each over 120,000 square feet), large ballrooms, the Theater, scores of smaller meeting rooms, and the Arena, home for the San Antonio Spurs.

The Hotels: Two Marriott hotels, the Riverwalk and Rivercenter, are literally across the street from each other and the Convention Center. The Rivercenter is linked to the Rivercenter Mall, with dozens of shops and restaurants. The Mall, hotels, and Convention Center are linked by a branch of the world-famous Paseo del Rio, the River Walk. You can easily walk from one to another without dealing with traffic and enjoy the cool, shaded comfort of the San Antonio River. There are a dozen other hotels within three or four *small* blocks in all prices, from the stately Menger to La Quinta.

**Food:** Every conceivable type of cuisine and setting is within easy walking distance. From McDonald's to the Tower of the Americas, every price range is available for every palate.

Parking: More than you really want to think about, from a couple of dollars a day on up.

**Getting to San Antonio:** Flying in, the International Airport is on every major airline's route. It's only 15 to 20 minutes from downtown by taxi, courtesy van, or Via, the metro transportation system. For drivers, San Antonio is located at the crossroads of IH-35 and IH-10.

Other Attractions: San Antonio offers plenty for vacationers: Sea World of Texas, the Texas Fiesta theme park with the world's tallest wooden roller coaster, museums, and a world-class zoo. The Gulf of Mexico and NASA's Johnson Space Center are only a couple of hours away by car.

**Pre-Supporting Memberships:** Your donation helps finance parties and other activities to spread the word about San Antonio. This kind of membership costs just \$8 US. In return, you receive a newsletter detailing our progress (and some of the things being done to promote the bid) and a really cool button. Pre-Opposing Memberships are \$10 US and come with the same benefits. There are additional classes of memberships if you're interested.

You can also become a supporting or attending member of Conadian, the 1994 Worldcon, and participate in site selection by voting for San Antonio. Attending memberships are \$85 US 'til September 6, 1993; supporting memberships are \$25 US. Write to them at: Conadian, P.O. Box 2430, Winnipeg, Manitoba, Canada R3C 4A7.
