## **1981 Site Selection Voting Instructions**

**1.** Fill in your name, address, **Seacon** '79 membership number, and signature on the other side of this form. You should give the address that you want the winning bidder to have in their files for you. If you don't know your membership number, say so and give a brief explanation. If you are not a **Seacon** '79 member, you must enclose an additional \$10.00 (US) or £5.50 (UK) with your ballot to join as a supporting member (or \$20.00 (US) or £11.00 (UK) to become an attending member).

2. Indicate your vote preferentially below. You should put a "1" by your first choice for the 1981 Worldcon site, a "2" by your second choice, etc. If your first place choice is eliminated, your ballot will be counted for your second place choice and if that is also eliminated, for your third place choice, etc. If you vote first for "No Preference" or all those you vote for as better choices than it are eliminated, your ballot will have no further effect in choosing the 1981 site. If you put some mark by only one bidder and nothing by the others, you will be counted as having voted first for that bidder and if they are eliminated you ballot will have no further effect on the site selection.

**3.** You must include \$5.00 (US) or £2.50 (UK) or equivalent with this ballot. This amount will count towards your membership in the 1981 Worldcon, regardless of who wins.

**4.** Either (A) mail this ballot to Seacon '79, Site Selection, 14 Henritta Street, London WC2E 8QJ, United Kingdom by 1 August 1979 or (B) bring it to Seacon '79 and hand it in at the site selection table before voting closes at 6PM Saturday 25 August 1979.
