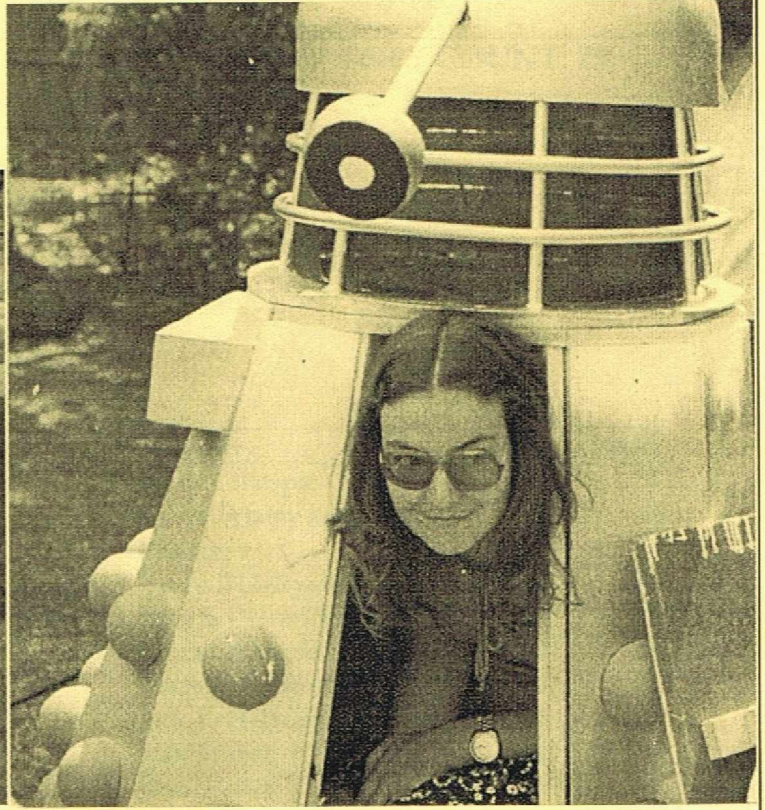

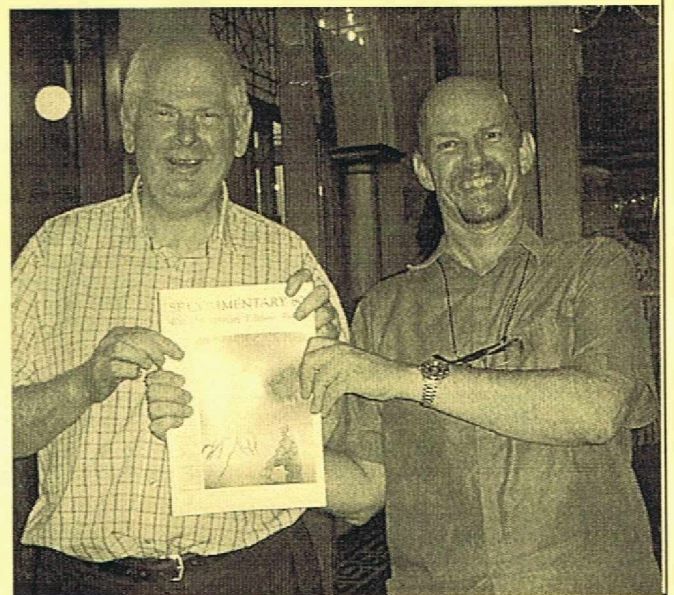
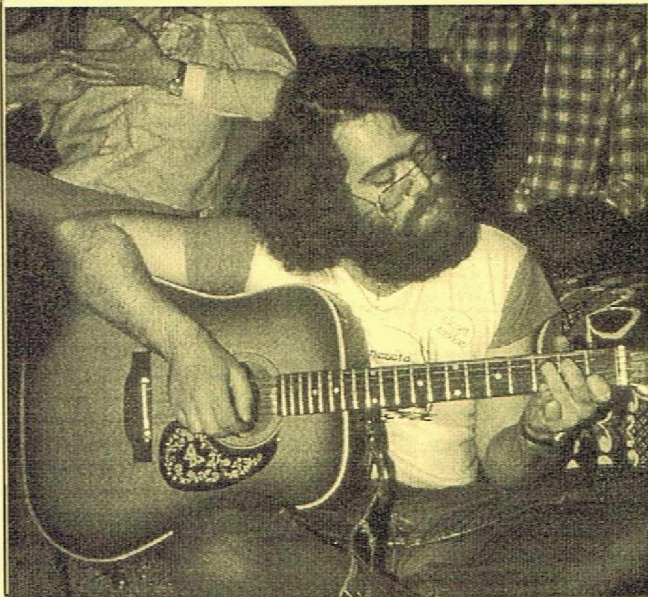

Cover photos

Thanks again to those people who have responded to my pleas for historical photos.

On the front cover, you can see a photo of **Mike Glicksohn** and **Susan Wood** in 1970, when they were very young, in 1970, and married. Recently we were saddened to hear of the death of Mike in Toronto, at the age of 64, of bladder cancer. Susan died suddenly in 1979. They were our Fan Guests of Honour at Aussiecon 1, 1975. Although they were together when we asked them to be our Fan GoHs, by 1973, when we won the bid, they had split up. They agreed to remain join Fan Guest of Honour, and each did a superb job. Susan was a member of ANZAPA for several years in the early 1970s. Thanks to **Andy Porter** for sending me this photo.

What I did not know until a few weeks ago is that Mike Glicksohn visited Australia again, in 2008, but saw only **Jean** and **Eric** in Airlie Beach. Jean has sent me some photos of Mike's visit.

As I mentioned last time, **Joy Window** has sent some wonderful photos from her time as an Adelaide fan in the 1970s. Here she emerges from her Dalek after competing in the Dalek Race at Unicon, Easter 1976, Melbourne University.

Here is one of the fine set of photos that **John Newman** has sent me from (he remembers) 1981. **Marc Ortlieb**, who was then an Adelaide fan, was already one of Australia's best-known singers and composers of filksongs.

Nick Shears first joined ANZAPA in 1971 or 1972, when he was living in South Africa. He dropped out, then I later heard from him after he had moved to Britain with his new wife **Audrey**. He rejoined ANZAPA briefly in the late seventies or early eighties, then wrote from me after he and his family had moved to Brisbane in (I think) the early nineties. He joined ANZAPA for the third time, but was forced to retire hurt a few years ago after he was diagnosed with a brain tumour. The tumour was removed entirely, and Nick has been enjoying a normal, but much too busy life ever since. In all this time we had never met in person, until about a month ago we spent an enjoyable time nattering in the bar of the Princess Theatre while Audrey and his daughter **Thembi** took in a show (*Hairspray*).
