**JANUARY.** Maskman, the mysterious scientific force behind Continent-Eight, utilizes his lunite belt-buckle ray projector (only known protection against Solara) to blind the stranger, the equally mysterious aspirant to membership in the *UNCLE Swashbucklers*, in "Meeting of the Mystery Men".

**FEBRUARY.** Sean Scott, Scotsman doomed to the loss of his features by the magical Rite of the Black Mask, uses his magic shield and sword to fight the sorcerer Zarbeth, only to have him become a fier-breathing dragon, in "Storming Stambold".

**MARCH.** Through a series of carefully conceived robberies, Doctor Double "X" has caused the Titan and the Meteor each to believe the other to be working with the doctor, and, having lured them to his hideout, is about to become impalpable, leaving them to fight it out, in "Doctor Double X Strikes Twice".

And when Jim, as The Bat found himself at the mercy of The Leader, he found an unexpected ally in Crime Lord the Octopus, helping out only because he hates The Leader more, in *The Leader Versus the Octopus*.

Doctor Yalta and Valarie Carruthers thought they were in the company of their partner Yaran Haruchi, but are confused by the sight of two more -- who, as it happens, are CL himself, and XO, the Clone, who, created by a combination of science and magic, believes himself to be the Emperor, in "Cloning Around".
