Martian mineral, Rare on Earth, Found Locked in Antarctic Ice

Scientists boring more than a mile deep into Antarctic ice have unearthed a mineral that's rarely seen on Earth but found in abundance on Mars, Science Magazine reported. The yellow-brown mineral, called jarosite, requires both water and acidic conditions to form, according to NASA— conditions that are hard to find now on the Red Planet. Nonetheless, after the Opportunity rover first discovered jarosite on Mars in 2004, the mineral turned up in several Martian locations, leaving scientists to wonder how the mineral became so common, Science reported.

The prototype Xenomorph costume is clearly the star.

Just like <u>May the Fourth</u> for "Star Wars" (**May 4**) and now <u>First Contact Day</u> for "Star Trek" (**April 5**), the "Alien" franchise too has assigned a tenuous calendar date to market new merchandise and make public any big, new announcements.

The selected date is **April 26** and the association is the planet formerly designated <u>as LV-426</u> in the epic 1986 sequel "Aliens." This of course is the same planet that the alien derelict spacecraft is discovered in the original 1979 movie "Alien," so it's pretty important in the story timeline.

International Space Station to go on tour with VR exhibit 'The Infinite' By Robert Z. Pearlman

For the past two years, Felix & Paul Studios, in collaboration with TIME Studios, has worked with eight international astronauts to film more than 200 hours of VR (virtual reality) footage on the space station. In 2020, the studios began releasing "Space Explorers: The ISS Experience," a four-part immersive series for Oculus headsets. "THE INFINITE" expands upon that project to bring the sense of being in space to more audiences.

"From its inception, this project was designed to be natively cross-platform, so we could reach billions of people across the world," said Raphaël.

"THE INFINITE," which launches in Montreal this summer, brings together the VR headset experience with a 10,000-square-foot (930-square-meter) installation.
