"UNKNOWN gres large size," said Mr. Compbell, and history was made! For with those words UNKNOWN become the · first fantasy magazine that started life small size and then went large size. UNKNOWN's name will be changed to UNKNOWN WORLDS, so as to explain its contents better. It will now be $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x 11" in size, contain 128 pages and 105,000 words, which means that the present contents can be published plus a long novel, like the old days. The new price will be 25¢ and the magazine will continue to be published bi-monthly. The first issue of the large size will be the October 1941 issue. The August 1941 isrue will be smill size. The cover will remain the same as is, anly the cover paper will be thicker. The magazine will be like DETECTIVE STORY ANNUAL that Street and Smith published recently.

WILL ASTOUNDING follow UNKNOWN and become large size ton? That is a question that will probably be answered by the success of the lorge size UNKNOWN. But then ASTOUNDING is doing quite well as is, so why change?? Time will tell!
