This is an index to Astounding Stories for the years it was owned by Clayton Magazines and edited by Harry Bates. William H Evans went thru his file, classifying each story, and prepared the manuscript. Jack Speer typed it up and duplicated it, and is principally responsible for the choice and arrangement of material in each of the sections.

We hope that this booklet will serve as an index for a limited time only. It is intended as a pilot model for an index of all commercial fantasy magazines, to test methods of presentation and to stimulate interest in the larger project. The editor urges that the forms mentioned below be followed by those who stencil the complete index. The columnation, indentation, punctuation, the very spacing (elite type is highly desirable), if followed by all concerned, will result in an index uniform thruout, and one in the shape most convenient to the user and at the same time most economical of time and space in production.

This booklet is divided into four sections:

The first gives the contents for each issue, issues arranged chronologically. In the top line are the month, the cover artist, and volume & number. Below this, leaders alternating dots and dashes are used to make it easier to follow the lines across. A \* in the margin opposite a title means that that story is illustrated on the cover. The title of each story is followed by the author's name, and then a three-letter abbreviation for the illustrator (i have no key to these). Following this are symbols indicating story length: SS for short story, NV for novel or novelet, SR for serial, A for article. In the last column is the subject classification for the story. The key to this classification is in the fourth section of the booklet. This first section contains all information about the magazines except the true names of authors (which are in the second section) and the linkage of series and sequels (which is in the third section).

The second section is a finding-list arranged by authors. Stories are entered under the name given at their publication; pseudonyms are cross-referenced. The stories of each author are arranged chronologically, so that one may trace the development of a writer's style and subjects. We have squeezed in the decimal classifications also so it will be easy to observe what types of stories an author favors. The finding-lists have been double-columned and less-important information omitted (since it can be found in the first section), in order than an index to all prozines following the same forms may not run to prohibitive pageage. The issue-reference is given in a condensed manner, "Oct50Ast" instead of "Oct. '50 Ast." or the confusing "AST 10/30". Serials are indexed to the date on which they begin.

The third section is another finding-list, titles arranged alphabetically. Definite and indefinite articles at the beginning of a title are ignored in the alphabetical arrangement, of course, but are not transposed to the end of the phrase. Sequels and series have been noted where known. The information on series has mostly been abstracted from a dubious ditto copy of the old Imag-Index, and it is doubtful that it is entirely accurate. With this finding-list there was space to give either the author or the classification, and it was decided to give the classification, the reasoning being that if one knows the author of the story he is looking for, he can conveniently check in the author finding-list. But if the title is all one knows, he may be doubtful of the exact wording of that, and an indication of subjectmatter may be helpful.

The fourth section gives the categories of the decimal classification developed by Speer and others, and modified somewhat by Evans on the basis of his experience in classifying. The version given here is not subject to further change (save possibly additions) for some years now. Incorporated into the fourth section are the stories from the Clayton Astounding, thus assisting, extensionally, in defining the meaning of the decimal numbers. The classification, however, was made for the stories, not the stories for the classification. Under each number, the stories are further broken down when there is a second, alternative, classification or an auxiliary symbol, by arranging such stories following those without such additional classification. The results of this additional breakdown are not so important with the simple plots of the Clayton era as they will be with the crossbred stories of the present day, and the large number of stories there will be in each category in a complete prozine index. Secondly the stories are arranged according to date of appearance, as in the author finding-list, so that the development of a particular theme can be traced down thru the years.

Comments, criticisms, and corrections are invited.
