Documenting fannish history is a pet project of mine. In between convention and club activities, I have been compiling zines, writing and publishing histories and reprint collections, and indexing since the mid'70s.

Since **MagiCon**, I've finally had some time to put to this interest.

Background

While many of us have talked about this for years, only a few people had been doing any historical work since Harry Warner, Jr., stopped — or so we thought. Peggy Rae Pavlat, Bruce Pelz and I had our own private crusade of programs at conventions to talk up the subject. The Noreascon 3 FanHistory Exhibits (which Peggy Rae started) were the impetus, I think, for a revival of interest in our past.

Finally, two years ago, the three of us decided to try to set up a "Clearing House" to see what was out there and to encourage people to let others know what had been done and what was being done. The first FanHistoricon, in May 1994, was a qualified success. The TimeBinders came out of it. So did the idea that there were many people interested in FanHistory outside of the core group of fanzine fans.

I haven't been able to make it to the last two FanHistoricon's and I have not seen any real summary about what was done at them. I hope someone will do that in FHAPA. Two things have resulted from them: the TimeBinders on-line discussion run by Dick Smith and the new Fan History Amateur Press Association (FHAPA) being set up by Lindsay Crawford. I hope FHAPA has as much participation as the on-line discussion.

Current

This zine is intended to be a working publication displaying the progress of the projects I am working on.

The biggest thing is the **FanHistory Archive Project**. I have been doing parts of this for years but I hope that I have now gotten enough interest from other people to undertake to put it on-line so others will be able to access it. This will probably be the most useful way of compiling and disseminating data and giving people a chance to critique it before making any final publication. The format and scope of this project is still being developed.

The other sizable project is the **Fanzine Indices**. I am indexing what I consider to be the most important and interesting fanzines. For variety I keep several in progress at any one time. I have

completed a few zines. A copy of the index to Walt Willis's *Slant* is included in this issue. Also included is a list of zines I intend to index. Eventually, these will all be accessible on-line. Along with the *Slant Index* is a listing of the fields (with input definitions) I am using to make the indices. I am using FileMaker Pro which is available for PC and Mac (I use a Mac). It is the same program that Don Fitch is using for his index of *Mimosa*. FileMaker is extremely easy to use and it provides the best formatting tools of any database I have seen. It also allows so many input and output alternatives that it is perfect to work with other people using different programs.

I have also been putting my **Fanzine Collection** in a database using the same program. It is up to about 10,000 different zines right now, with entire apa mailings being considered as one zine. I haven't yet undertaken to list everything in each apa. I think I am about 20% through the files and boxes. This is a great way to find duplicates. I have included the first two pages of the **Collection List** along with the field definitions for anyone interested. Bruce Pelz and Greg Pickersgill have both indicated an interest in making all our lists compatible so that they can be used as checklists for others. Eventually we hope to put these up on-line as well.

Wanted

I have several zines that I need to make complete sets so that I can index some major titles. In some cases I need to confirm that I have a complete run. I will be asking for some of these in the apa. If you would like to trade some zines, I would be very interested. I have some hard to find zines that might be of interest, including, *Hyphens*, *Quandry*, *Warhoon*, *Spaceways*, *Fantasy Magazine* and lots more.

I need: Hanson's *Nova Terrae* #22 & 24, *Spaceways* #2, Hornig's *Fantasy Fan* #5, 13-17, Laney's *Acolyte* #1-7, 11, Lupoff's *Xero* - all, Ackerman's *Voice of the Imagi-Nation* #1 & about 10 more issues.

I want to know the number of issues of each of the following fanzines:

FanHistory Archive Project

Description

Compile a historical archive of fanzines, convention publications, photos and other materials to preserve them for their historic and literary interest. Access to this archive to be available for research, exhibits, and educational purposes.

Reasoning

SF and SF Fandom have generated a tremendous amount of interest and activities over the past century. Most of the materials produced are rare, and had a very small distribution. Quite a bit of the material produced was of a high caliber and many professionals in the literature and the arts of the 20th Century produced amateur materials while they were active in SF fandom. These items should be preserved for their own intrinsic value, interest and entertainment, and also for their historic study — cultural and literary.

Purpose

- a) Obtain and preserve the physical, and often ephemeral and fragile paper materials that represent the history of science fiction and especially science fiction fandom.
- b) Preserve the content of these items in a more permanent and accessible form so that the materials may be transferred and accessed by a wide variety of methods, electronically and in print.

Preservation Methodology

- a) To collect such materials and arrange for accessible archives of original or copied materials
- b) Original materials would be stored flat or in files in dark, air-conditioned areas.
- c) Valuable items would be kept in non-acidic folders or sleeves for better preservations, especially older more fragile items.
- d) Individual items would be scanned and stored electronically as graphic files. (Those with desirable written materials might be OCR scanned later to make those files more easily accessible.)
- e) To photocopy materials, as necessary, for distribution

Goals

1. To preserve original science fiction and fannish materials
2. To make copies of related written and visual images
3. To record and preserve existing related recordings
4. To be able to make copies of these available to others
5. To encourage others to preserve such materials and coordinate with them

6. To obtain inventories of these other archives (and possibly copies of the materials)
7. To publicize this project to get materials and help

Types of materials to preserve

1. Fanzines
2. Photos
3. Ephemera
4. Trophies & plaques
5. Audio recordings (non-commercial)
6. Films & video recordings (non-commercial)
7. Magazines & books (items that are no longer commercial)

Equipment needed

1. Computer
 2. Photo-copier
 3. Color scanner with automatic feed and slide/transparency adaptor
 4. Optical storage media
 5. Computer software
 6. Electronic camera
 7. High resolution laser printer
 8. Color printer (capable of reproducing photos)
- Distribution and Availability

Fanhhistory Archive Project - expanded description

1. Compile a historic archive of fanzines, photos, convention publications, and other memorabilia to preserve it and for use for exhibits, research, and possible reproduction for convention and historical publications.
2. Preserve the physical ephemeral and fragile paper materials. Identify individuals and organizations who will keep these in a dark, air conditioned area, but also allow access or research.
3. Preserve the content of the above items by scanning the materials and saving them electronically via optical and/or CD-ROM. Save them in a standard format that can be widely used on a variety of computer platforms (GIF or TIF files for example). This might also allow OCR reading at a later time.

Note - establish a technical task force to recommend formats and equipment with periodic reevaluations on media and format.

4. Archive the material in a way that can be duplicated and saved in multiple locations with the potential for being used by interested parties for scholarly research and hobby and/or recreational reading.
5. Compile, publish and distribute information, indices and reproductions of rare, worthwhile materials for the easier reference and to make the important

materials accessible to a wider range of interested parties and also to reproduce photos and materials for researchers, conventions and exhibits.

6. Publish quality material about SF and fannish history and reprint quality material to bring it to the attention of a modern audience.

7. Coordinate with several major fannish organizations and also with several academic institutions to have material archived for permanent accessibility by interested fans and researchers.

8. Use the materials preserved to develop and assist others in the development of historic and reference library materials.

9. Put on the nets via the World Wide Web or equivalent, so that information and material is available to review and to download.

- Titles are listed as printed on the page of the fanzine where they appear not as they might be in the ToC or on the cover. Exception: if a regular Column has a variant title, it is listed under the Column's title if discernible, with the variant in the notes.
