# N E F F E R S ' G U I D E T O C U R R E N T F A N Z I N E S

((Based on list originally compiled by Don Franston, with revisions and additions by Ralph M. Holland and others too numerous to mention.))

If you can write an interesting letter of comment, you may not have to spend much for fanzines. If you'd rather read than write, most of them will welcome subscriptions. Since the quality of fanzines varies as widely as do the tastes of the readers, it is advisable to either ask for or buy a sample copy before you take a long term subscription. No attempt has been made to rate the zines as to quality, altho it should be obvious that zines like Yandro, "Shaggy" and "Cry", which have been published for more than a hundred issues, are among the top of the heap. Most editors will give free copies for accepted contributions, and in trade for your zine (altho many are particular what they are trading for. You cannot expect a 50 page monthly in return for a semi-annual leaflet.)

The number in parentheses after the zine name indicates the number of issues published so far, to the best of our knowledge. The date of the last issue, where known, is listed immediately after this number. Schedules are as listed in the zines themselves. It is assumed that, unless otherwise stated, all zines are regular letter-size, and are produced by some stencil process, such as Mimeograph. "Ditto" refers to zines produced by any spirit-process similar to Ditto. British and other foreign "letter sizes" are slightly different than U.S. standard. Fanzines published by members of the NFFF are marked with \*.

Most fanzines carry a wide variety of different kinds of material and so, to save space, only the major varieties are listed. "Stf" here means articles about science-fiction. Fiction itself is listed as such. Activities of fans, told by themselves, such as conventions attended, parties and club meetings, etc., is here listed as "Fanac", altho the word may have different meanings elsewhere. "Reviews" and "Lettercol" should be self-explanatory.

So far as is possible, the list is confined to fanzines which are available to any fan, regardless of membership in any group or club. Therefore: Official Organs of clubs which are ordinarily restricted to their own members, and zines produced for any of the several Amateur journalism clubs, are not listed except where these are also available by subscription or otherwise.

It should be noted that, in the case of foreign fanzines, those published in non-English speaking countries are in the language of that country unless there is a specific notation to the contrary. Many of these overseas zines have U.S. agents to whom you may send your subscriptions. We suggest that, if you are interested in any of these zines, you write for a sample copy, which will usually contain the name and address of the current U.S. agent.

Fanzines are born and "folded" at a rapid rate. We have tried to eliminate all the deadwood, and to list all the new ones insofar as our information goes. We have no illusions that the list is either complete or completely accurate. Additional information or corrections, either by the publishers or by readers, should be sent to the editor of TNFF, and will be appreciated.
