Introduction

Just over two months to go and Conflux will be opening its doors. After receiving the disappointing news that Harry Turtledove was canceling his Pacific Tour, we had to get to work again on rejigging the program and altering our promotional material. However, we have such a fantastic line up of guests and panelists that the gap caused by Harry's absence won't be too noticeable. Greg Benford is putting together his traveling plans for a grand tour of Downunder and Middle Earth (NZ in the common tongue). We've had more hands up from prestigious panelists during the time the draft program went up for comment. We've had some screams already from members torn between two or three choices. The Committee have things well under control to present you with an amazing con. We hope it will be the best ever.

Ditmars

Ditmars nominations closed on 13 February. Voting will remain open for 30 days. At this stage, we envisage that voting will commence by 1 March and cease by 31 March. Keep an eye out for voting forms on the Conflux website. Remember that you need to be a member – either full or supporting – to vote in the Ditmars.

Accommodation
