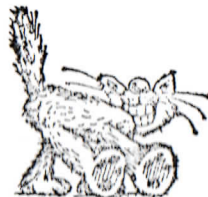

Progress Report Two.**May 1992**

Welcome to the second Progress Report for Constantinople, the 33rd Australian SF Convention, to be held in Melbourne over Easter 1994.

GUESTS OF HONOUR: So far we have confirmed our international Professional Guest of Honour and two Fan Guests of Honour. There is a possibility for a further Special Guest but nothing can be announced until nearer the Convention date. As we are also bidding to host the 1994 Australasian SF Media Convention we cannot announce our Guests of Honour at the moment. Please bear with us until after the Business Meeting at Hongcon, 7 June 1992.

MEMBERSHIP RATES: Full Attending Membership will be \$ 80 until 31 December 1992. This may be paid in instalments, and, if necessary, a new rate will be set after that date.

Supporting Membership is available for \$20, and Voting Membership for \$5.

ACCOMMODATION: The Convention Hotel will be the Southern Cross, 131 Exhibition Street, in central Melbourne. Room rates are currently being negotiated and will be announced when available. All Hotel booking should be done through the Convention address and a Hotel Booking Form will be circulated when all the details are finalised.

Overflow accommodation is also available at nearby Hotels, such as the Victoria, and we are looking at special Convention rates in similar venues for members who do not wish to stay at the Southern Cross.

INFORMATION ABOUT OUR LOGO

Alan Stewart asked me to provide some details for this PR regarding Constantinople the three legged feline mascot and hero of the Convention in '94. Well what does one say about a three legged cat ?

Firstly, Constantinople is approximately 5½ years old. The oldest drawing of him exists to my knowledge on page 4 of a fanzine titled The Adventures of Man N° 9 published in March 1986. In October of the same year I published Constantinople the Brave, Fun with a Three Legged Cat. It was a 20 page colour-in book that was handed out to fans, Hare Krishnas and anybody who was interested in it.

Since then the happy three legged pussy cat has had appearances in various places, not just in fanzines! He has been scrawled on bits of paper and pinned up on walls at parties usually with the victorious slogan 'Constantinople Lives!'. Then there was the time I constructed a life size blue three legged cat in the form of a child's wooden toy on wheels. It was given to Danny Heap for his birthday:

Now Constantinople has the unique and honourable position as Convention logo. I am personally glad to see him employed in this manner. It guarantees his survival. He won't just disappear into obscurity as part of some forgotten fanzine.
