Thylacon 2005 has moved hotels. Our new site, Wrest Point, is a fabulous convention centre right on the waterfront of Hobart. The complex is self-contained with various cafes, bars and restaurants on site to suit a variety of budgets. The Busy Bee buses run every 30 minutes from outside the hotel into Sandy Bay & the city centre, which enables quick trips back and forth for shopping, etc.

### Code Noir out now!



Code Noir, the second Parrish Plessis novel by Thylacon GoH Marianne de Pierres, is in the shops now! In this fiery sequel to Nylon Angel, it's time for Parrish to repay her blood debt to the shadowy and dangerous Cabal Coomera, with a mission that will take her into the heart of tekno-darkness, the slum town of Dis, and back into conflict with the treacherously attractive Loyl me Daac.

The third Parrish Plessis novel, Crash Deluxe, will be released in June 2005.

#### Parrish Fan Fic Competition!

A Parrish Plessis fan fiction competition will be held to celebrate the release of *Crash Deluxe*, the final chapter of Parrish's exploits, and in honour of Thyla-

con 2005. The competition will open to both Thylacon members and non-members and will be judged by Marianne de Pierres and her editor at Orbit, Darren Nash.

Your task will be to write a fiction of no more than 600 words, taking Parrish out of her world, and placing her in a contemporary setting where conflict arises - e.g. the hairdresser turns her hair the wrong colour, she gets short-changed at the supermarket, working as a secretary she gets harassed by her boss, etc. It may be as humorous or serious as you like.

Winners of the Con-members section will be published on Marianne's website and in the Thylacon Souvenir Book and will receive autographed copies of *Nylon Angel*, *Code Noir* and *Crash Deluxe*.

Winners of the open section (non-members) will also be published on Marianne's website and in the Orbit e-zine and received autographed copies of *Nylon Angel*.

Hobart Airport is approx 20-minute drive from Wrest Point. Airport shuttles to Wrest Point are \$9.00 or \$23.00 by taxi.




## Thylacon family membership rates

# The Thylacon Art Show Green Room Wrest Point Hotel and Casino Hobart Tasmania 12, 13 June 2005

The **Thylacon Art Show** will be part of an exciting program that is now growing for the June 2005 NatCon. So scrub up the brushes, sharpen the chisels, the artists are on!

We anticipate putting a big spotlight on **The Art Show** as a major program event. As the location for The Art Show will be in the midst of the spectacular Wrest Point Casino complex, it will be also be open to the general public on the Sunday, for a door fee. (Thylacon folk, of course, get in free.) That means more exposure for the artists and more publicity for science fiction and fantasy artwork.

And check updates on the website for additional art events in connection with The Art Show.

Check out the basic information below so that you can wrap your ideas around the event.

- The main viewing day will be on Sunday. Judging will be during the day and prize giving will be held after the evening dinner break. The evening will also see an art event and full details will be published later. Monday will focus on finalising sales.
- The Thylacon 2005 Art Show is open to both fannish and professional artists. We welcome all sorts of two dimensional and three dimensional fantasy, science fiction and horror artwork. Work can also be judged in the theme category if you request this on your Registration Form: Where the Wild Things Are, as immortalised in our icon, the thylacine.

All submitted pieces must be the artist's original work.

We regret that no pieces made from commercial moulds or kits can be accepted.

• 5 categories will be offered initially and we may extend these to further categories. Convention staff also reserves the right to merge categories if numbers warrant it:

2 dimensional professional

2 dimensional fan

3 dimensional professional

3 dimensional fan

#### Best theme artwork overall

- Sale of work will be undertaken by convention staff, and artists should price their work beforehand on their Registration Form. A numbered catalogue will be produced for viewers and potential buyers. Pieces not intended for sale will be so noted on the catalogue.
- There will be no general dutch auction, but if an artist wishes to donate an artwork to charity, an auction could be arranged. Please notify your intention on your Registration form. An artwork for charity will not be charged a registration fee.
- There will also be shared table space to leave your business cards or fliers, and we will endeavour to keep this area tidy and business like.

Check out The Art Show Rules on our website. You'll be able to access the Registration Form and full details of how to enter your work, show it, sell it, retrieve it, including financial matters, check-ins and -outs, diary dates and times, and other issues which will help to make your experience as stress free as possible.

And remember, it is not a condition of The Art Show that an artist has to sell their work.
