From her first sale（＂Defense Mechanism＂to ミSTOUNDING in 1949）Katherine Maclean has had a reputation 末or thought－三ul，provocative Eiction rich in humanity．The small scraps oE information I＇ve been able to gather indicate a writer whose work reslects a varied and interesting life，rather than sheer imagination－－not that she doesn＇t have more than her share of that basic writer＇s tool．

Maclean received a BA Erom Barnard in 1950，and has de－ voted much of her subsequent life to educational reform－ Erom lectures at the Free Universities o三 ヨerkeley and Marin County and an experimental high school in Elorida，to help－ ing organize a Eree University in her home town o三 Portiand， Maine．

Maclean＇s oeuvre is relatively small，possibly die to her varied outside interests and commitments，comprising a－ cout Eorty shor亡 stories and a hal三 dozen novels，including the well known THE DIPLOIDS．3ut each new story is greeted With delight and anticipation by discerning readers every－ where（and once，in the case o三 the memorable＂The Missing Man＂ir 1971，a long overdue Nebula）．

She has said that：＂For me，the work of writing sci－ ence Eictior is an integration oミ li三etime studies o三 psy－ chology，biclogy，and history．It is a way to think．＂J quote Erom H．G．Nells－－＂The 20th Century will be a race be－ tween education and disaster．＂－－nas＂molded my ii三e＂．
Katherine Yaclean looks upon science Eiction－－a natural me－ dium for exploring the e三ミacts o三 current Erends－as＂．．．a supreme method EO：populǎ education．＂

As $\equiv$ individual，I admire ner dedication and interest in education and the learning process in gereral．But，as a reader oE sE，my baser instircts come to the Eore and I must express a selfish desire to see more Eiction coming Erom hez tyontiter－realizing that it wouid probably cut into time spent on more vital projects．
