Please read this before voting:

Please vote by the entry number in the upper right corner of the bid sheet attached to the artwork. Artists' names or titles of works are not acceptable and will not be counted. You may give a first and second choice for each category, or you may list a single choice if you prefer.

All artwork in the show is eligible for awards, including the items on the tables and pieces that are not for sale. Some artists may choose not to compete, however, and any such artwork will be marked "Not in Competition".

Anateur and professional artwork is judged separately. The bid sheet will tell you which is which, and in addition, the two types of artwork are hung on opposite sides of the room.

The categories are not written on the bid sheets and are for you to determine. Here is a rough guide to what we mean by the various categories:

Science Fiction: depictions of the future, alien worlds, technology, robots, etc.
Fantasy: mythology, magic (unicorms, sorcerers, demons, etc.)
Astronomical: stars, planets, asteroids, etc.
Humor is obvious (we hope)
Best of Show is the best of any category.

It is possible that a piece of art will fall into two or more of these categories (Fantasy and Humor, for example) and it is perfectly all right to list it in both places on your ballot. You do not have to vote in every category for your ballot to be valid.
