

Boskone 15 Restaurant Guide, February 1978

This is a guide to restaurants it would be easy to walk to from Boskone 15. It includes restaurants in the Sheraton-Boston Hotel, in the adjoining Prudential Center, along the adjacent part of Boylston Street, and in the neighborhood.

IN THE HOTEL — (complete list)

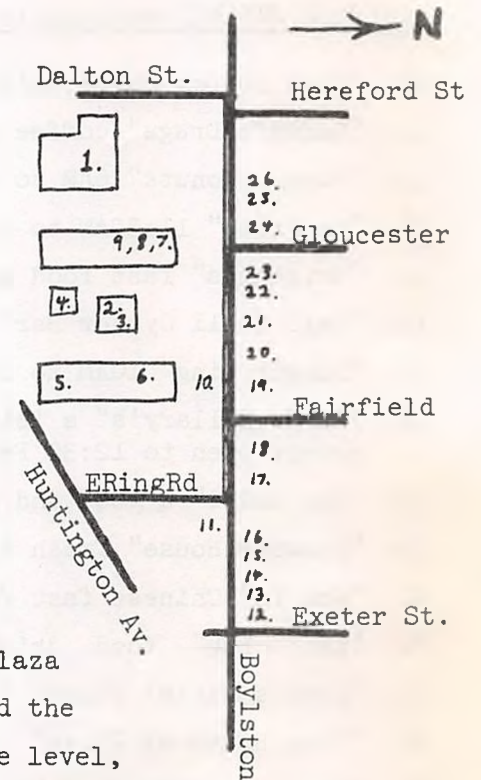
Item 1 in the map is the Sheraton-Boston Hotel. The most convenient restaurants are, of course, those in the hotel. On the first floor, or lobby level, there is the "Kon Tiki Ports" and the "Mermaid Room", on the second floor, or plaza level, there is the "Falstaff Room", the "Persian Lounge", and the "Pavilion Coffee House", and on the third floor, or conference level, there is "Shelley's Upstairs Pub". If you are staying in the hotel you can charge meals to your room. There is also the "Ice Cream Parlor" on the second floor and room service. You should be able to find out all about these from the signs around the hotel or by calling the hotel. The Kon Tiki, Mermaid, and Falstaff are particularly recommended.

IN THE PRUDENTIAL CENTER — (complete list)

2. "Top of the Hub" fancy restaurant at the top of the Prudential Tower. Lunch 11:30 to 3PM. Dinner 5:30 to 11PM Fri&Sat, 4:30 to 9PM Sun. Happy hour 4-7PM, drinks 99¢ at the bar. One story above item 3 listed next. Reservations tel. 536-1775.
3. The Skywalk, not a restaurant, see Boston from near the top of the Prudential Tower. \$1.00 Adult, 50¢ child. 9AM to midnight Fri&Sat, 10AM to 11PM Sun.
4. Where's Boston, not a restaurant, multi-media show on Boston hourly 10AM to 10PM Fri through Sun.
5. "Ground Round", a robust eating and drinking establishment, 11:30AM to 1AM and on Mon through Sat. Happy Hour 2PM to 7PM drinks \$1.15.
6. "Brigham's" miscellaneous fast food and ice cream (see also item 15). 7AM till midnight except Sunday 9AM till midnight.
7. "The Gourmet Shoppe" fancy food and deli store, not a restaurant, 8AM to 6PM Mon through Sat.
8. "Gloucester Wine & Spirits" a liquor store, not a restaurant, 9:30AM to 11PM Fri&Sat.
9. Prudential Center Pharmacy, not a restaurant but might be useful, 8AM to 9PM except 9:30AM to 5:30PM Sat and 9:30AM to 5PM Sunday.

BOYLSTON STREET FROM EXETER TO HEREFORD — (complete list)

10. STAR, a supermarket not a restaurant, open all the time except Sunday.

11. "Olde London Pub & Grille" 11:30AM to 1AM except to 10PM Sunday.
12. "Guild's Drugs" coffee shop 7AM to 11PM all days.
13. "Dunkin Donuts" 6AM to midnight all days.
14. "La Crêpe" 11:30AM to 11PM Sun through Thursday, to 1AM Fri&Sat.
15. "Brigham's" fast food and ice cream (see also item 6) 24 hours, 7 days/week.
16. "Half Shell Oyster Bar" liquor and sea food, 8AM to 2AM except opens 11:30 Sun.
17. "Burger King" 10AM to 11PM Mon through Sat, 11AM to 11PM Sun.
18. "J. C. Hillary's" a 'city tavern', 11:30 to 3:30 lunch, 3:30 to midnight dinner except open to 12:30 Fri&Sat and till 11PM Sun.
19. "The Bulki" a good and popular deli, 7AM to 3AM all days.
20. "Chowder House" fresh fish, 11AM to 1AM Mon through Sat, 4PM to Midnight Sun.
21. "Wok In" Chinese fast food, 11AM to 11:30PM except till 9:30PM Sunday.
22. "Ken's Pub", food, drink, sounds, 11:30AM to 2AM except Sunday opens at noon.
23. "Zeke's Eatin' Place" 7:30AM till midnight all days.
24. "City House of Pizza" 10AM to 11PM except Sunday noon to 10:30PM.
25. "Honey Restaurant & Lounge" 6:30AM to 1AM except normally closed Sunday.
26. "The Kojon's Deli" 6AM to 7PM except closed Sunday.

IN THE NEIGHBORHOOD — (partial list)

Here are some additional good restaurants in the area.

- "Cafe Budapest" 90 Exeter Street (see map), telephone 734-3388. Relatively expensive, takes credit cards, entertainment nightly, an old-world romantic setting for continental dining.
- "Zachary's" in the Colonnade Hotel, 120 Huntington Avenue (see map), telephone 261-2800. Relatively expensive, an elegant formal restaurant.
- "Cafe Plaza" in the Copley Plaza Hotel, Copley Square (east on Huntington, see map) Telephone 267-5300, marbled floors, crystal chandeliers, velvet drapes.
- "Delmonico's" 66 Exeter Street (see map), telephone 536-2000. Victorian setting, continental cuisine, takes credit cards.
- "English Room" 29 Newbury Street (next street parallel to and north of Boylston) Telephone 262-5566 or 246-7231. Wholesome meals.
- "Joseph's Restaurant" 279 Dartmouth Street (see map), telephone 266-1502. Relatively expensive, takes credit cards, a modern setting for continental food. Closed Sunday.
- "Ken's at Copley" 549 Boylston Street (east of map), telephone 266-6149. Popular deli restaurant.
- "Kyoto" 267 Huntington Avenue (see map), telephone 536-9295. Excellant Japanese food.
- "The Magic Pan" 47 Newbury Street(next street paralalled to and north of Boylston), telephone 267-9315. Excellant crêpes, including desert crêpes, in a French country-inn atmosphere.
