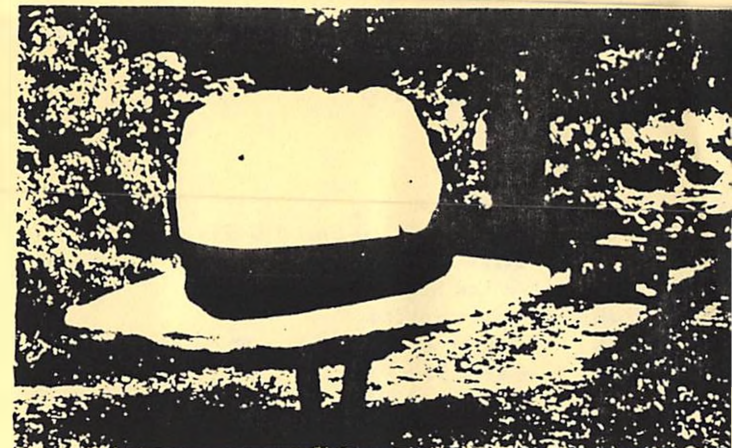
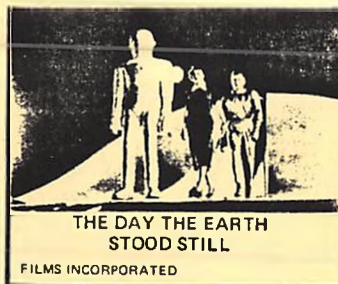

The Wizard of Speed & Time - Mike Jittlov's masterpiece of pixillation. Don't miss it!  
 Street Scene - What can a harried film director do with an out-of-place building?  
 At the Movies - Clay animation of the hazards of getting a seat at the movies.  
 Housemoving - Derek Lamb's time-lapse look at a New England tradition.  
 Spooky Boo's & Room Noodles - A new fairy tale from J.P. Somersaulter. Cute.  
 Hardware Wars - The classic send-up to end all send-ups. By Ernie Fosselius.  
 Muscle Control - Musclemen John Farbotnik's demonstration of silliness.  
 Silverfish King - Another Somersaulter film, where the narrator has a tenuous, at best, grip on reality. Fine Lovecraftian tone, creepy plot. Spooky!  
 Asteroid! - A new amateur short by Steve Parady, from Waltham, about the conflict between independent and "Company" asteroid miners. Many SFX.  
 Fish Heads - A film made from the underground hit song of the same name. It smells!  
 The Electric Disco Chicken - By Bob Goodness of Worcester. This was the only American super-8 film to be invited to Cannes this year. See them dance!  
 Brainwash - What happens if the downtrodden masses don't yearn to be free?  
 The Box - Academy Award Winner, 1968. A fable on communication & illusion.  
 Evolution - Our favorite cartoon of all time. Darwinism explained at 500 MPH.  
 Landscape - Chechoslovakian version of an alien "evolution". Surrealistic.  
 The Solar Film - Saul Bass contributed to this stylish plea for solar sanity.  
 Bambi Meets Godzilla/Bambi's Revenge - Be on time for these; they're quick!  
 Gravity - A spoof of Mr. Wizard, Walt Disney, and pompous science teachers.  
 Quaint Cafe - So you think rural life is bucolic and simple. Not so! It's weird!!!  
 Turkish Delight - Nejla Ates in a (for the time, 1949) verry daring belly dance.  
 The Signs of Quoctaas - Somersaulter's film about an alternate reality.  
 Celebrity Gag Commercials - The Flintstones selling cigarettes!?! etc., etc.....
