About our guests

Marilisa Valtazanou (guitar, voice, and most other instruments) was born in lowa, raised in Greece and now lives in London; she celebrates her multinational background by having a song in an obscure language for every occasion.

As half of Playing Rapunzel she is easily recognised as the band member who will fearlessly play any instrument, including mandola, flutes, percussion, and even electric double bass. As a sixteenth of the n'Early Music Consort. she demonstrates her versatility by moving between alto and solo parts.

She also performs as part of the Erato Consort, a group of singers specialising in unaccompanied music of the 16th and 17th centuries, and is an active member of the Chapel End Savoy Performers.

Heather Dale is a Canadian Celtic recording artist and touring musician. She records and performs primarily her own original songs, which draw their inspiration from the mythology, folklore and history of various Celtic and non-Celtic cultures. Her musical style is a mix of traditional and modern, with elements from Celtic folk, jazz, blues, folk-rock and world music influences.

Ben Deschamps has had enough random jobs that he would ordinarily only qualify for a career as an SF writer. Oddly enough, despite a potentially lucrative academic background in Classics and Middle English Philology, he's turned his back on this career (highlights include farming, teaching, construction, night shifts at Mac's Milk and gravedigging) - his last day of "real" work being more than five years ago - and has become a full-time musician. A lifelong SF fan, he has moved through musical genres like he has moved through jobs, and has played space rock, folk, Celtic, jazz, bluegrass, punk and the screamingest of screaming heavy metal, on a variety of instruments and continents.

Together they regularly perform extensive tours across Canada, the United Kingdom, the USA, and continental Europe (Germany, Hungary and Spain). In addition to vocals, Heather and Ben play as many as a dozen instruments in their duo shows, including piano, double bass, guitar, bodhran drum, mountain dulcimer, alto recorder, violin, and an array of Irish flutes & tin whistles.

Programming

There will of course be the usual items by other people (the guests, filk fund auction, circles, one-shots/main concert, workshops, etc.) but we'd like something else to fill up the time as well.

One of the programme items we're planning is an Advance Request Concert, where you, the members, get to choose what's performed. 'Advance' so that the performers get a chance to find the lyrics/practice songs they might not have played in years, where required! We'll be putting up a form on the website soon (along with a paper copy in PR2), where you can pick a performer, a song, or both, or several, and from those we'll put together the concert.

Programme slots will be available in two lengths - probably 'short' and 'long', but we'll decide on exactly how short and long those are when we have a better idea of how many requests we have. (Lots of requests may mean we'll stick to one shorter length only.) Get your requests in as soon as possible.

Note

- in the event that we have more requests than slots, we'll give priority to people who didn't have a set last year
- programme participants must be a member of the convention, ideally at the time of the request, otherwise by the cut-off date. The Programming Queen wields her sceptre of grace in this matter, using her own judgement of the reliability of the requester and/or the reason for the delay, if explained. If you're not a member by the time of the con, she reserves the right to chase you around the hotel with her frying pan for your membership fee or other such draconian measures. Please don't make her bring the frying pan to the con!
- If you are not sure of your exact tech requirements yet, please list everything you think you might need, and say what's definite and what's not and update later as you narrow things down. Remember to include the things that are "always there anyway." (They might not be, if nobody asks for them!)
