Introduction

With all the inevitability of "one man walks into a bar..." we bring you the second progress report for the 21st British Filk Convention, aXXidental. But no bananas.

Grantham Ramada Hotel

To book a room at the con hotel, you must go through the convention (if you go to the Ramada website, it'll seem to suggest it's all booked up!). **This PR includes the hotel booking form, which you should return to us by 31 DECEMBER 2008 to guarantee your room.**

About the hotel

Situated in Grantham (surprisingly enough) in Lincolnshire, the Ramada has good access by road (just off the A1), by rail (Grantham is on the East Coast main line from London Kings Cross), and air (East Midlands airport is only 37 miles away, and is a reasonably easy route by public transport). The hotel has one large (150-seater) conference room, two smaller (50-seater) ones, and four small boardrooms near the largest room. It has 86 guest bedrooms, a large open bar area with plenty of seating, and a pool and sauna. See www.ramada.com for more.

Twin or double: £40 per person per night

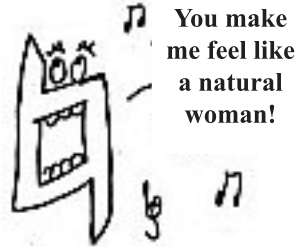
Single occupancy: £52.50 per night. All rates include breakfast.

And those five songs made it onto Mike's first tape, *The Oak, The Rowan and the Wild Rose*.

Except by then, Valerie, and Colin, and Phil, and Rhodri, and Vanessa, and heaven knows who else, had latched onto the story, contributing plot and characters in a disturbingly self-consistent way, almost as if the story already existed and was just waiting to be told. There was a handy plot guide, with new instalments every month or so (called 'A4 The Dawn' - you may all groan now), and characters, none of whom have actual names, ranging from the Prince, the Captain and the Rumour-Monger all the way down to the Warlord's Daughter's Music-Teacher's Cat. Which latter fortunately snuck off for a nap in a patch of sunlight before anyone could write a song about it.

It's a part of British Filk history. And someday, we always said we'd tell the story...

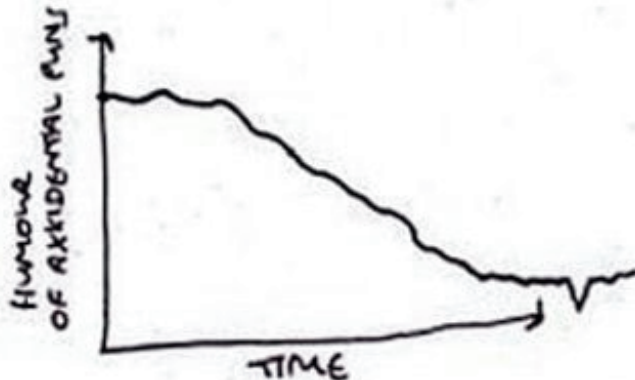
