As Capclave will be different from our past conventions, we're looking forward to our new format. Focusing on short stories means that we'll feature discussions with authors and editors, a



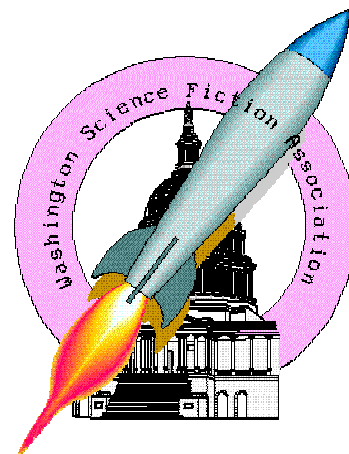
