There will also be a Saturday Afternoon banquet at the Sahara Steakhouse in Cave City limited to 55 people at a cost to be determined. You can still check out the downtown Horse Cave attractions such as the American Cave Museum and Hidden River Cave Tour, or you might just want to browse around the Dollar General Store and soak in rural Kentucky living at its finest!
