HUXTER ROOM INFORMATION

The Concave Huxter Room was sold out... For years... BUT now the Concave Village has opened our format up to having more Vendors. A limited number of hotel rooms in the Concave Village Area are available for vendors to operate in. Think strip mall store front except at Concave! Vendor Rooms are available for \$220 for the weekend (Friday and Saturday Night). The Vendor rooms are fully furnished hotel rooms located in the approved vendor area; the Concave Village. Concave will provide up to three 6 foot long tables per room. If you want to have furniture removed from the room arrangements must be made in advance with the hotel; which charges a \$125 fee per room to do this. Additionally there are a very limited number of single vendor tables available for \$80 each. Room and table prices do not include membership; which is required of all persons attending.
