Reservations must be made prior to **March 22, 2008** in order to obtain the special Corflu rate; after that date, the regular room rates will apply. Murray Moore will again be the Official Teller for the voting and Brad Foster has kindly consented to design the certificates given to the first-place finisher in each of the poll's eight categories.

Corflu Silver will email ballots on January 1. Fanzine and website editors are encouraged to send them out as widely as possible.

The success of last year's poll and subsequent discussions have determined that the practice of



voting for the FAAm Awards at Corflu is history. The voting deadline will be in early March...

Ultimately, we decided that the convenience of on-site voting is less important than providing time for careful tabulation and checking, the creation of inscribed certificates for first-place finishers in each category, and a special publication with detailed poll results.
