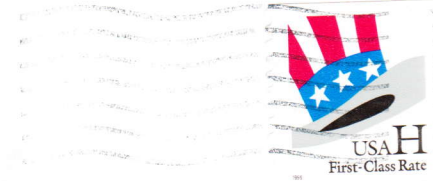
### GOING...GOING...online!

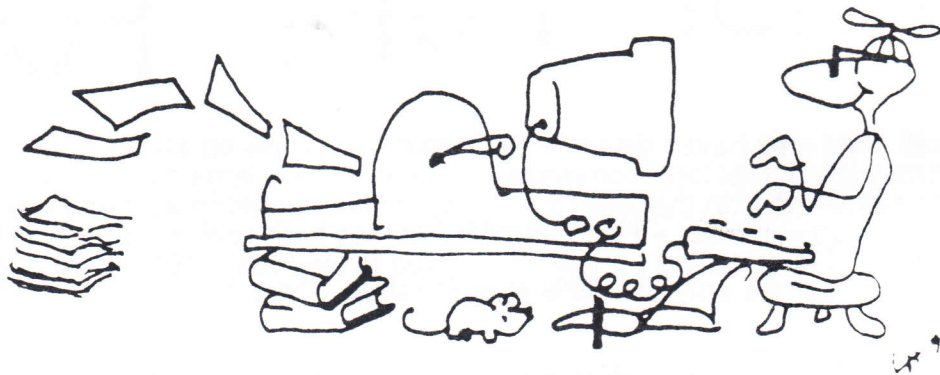
