

From Holiday Inn Select on Democrat:

Turn left out of the hotel and right (south) (first light) on Airways from the hotel.

The 2nd light you reach is Brooks Road, turn right (west). On Brooks Road you'll find:

Burger King - Brooks Road East

Mrs. Winner's Chicken - 1986 Brooks Rd E

Popeye's Chicken - 1430 Brooks Road East

The third light, just past Airport Chevrolet, is Winchester turn right (west). On Winchester you'll find:

Kelvin's BBQ & Wings – 1735 Winchester (good Memphis BBQ)

Wendy's - 1725 Winchester (the best in town)

McDonald's - 1666 Winchester (not the best)

Just across from this McDonald's is a grocery store (behind Mapco). Keep going west on Winchester, and it will lead you to Elvis Presley. Taco Bell, Captain D's and Walgreens are at Winchester & Elvis Presley. Turn right (north) onto Elvis Presley, there is an ExLine's Pizza just down to your left.

To get to Millbranch, turn RIGHT (west) in front of the hotel, heading away from

Airways. Hit Nonconnah which runs on the far side of the hotel from Airways.

Follow Nonconnah around until it dead ends on Millbranch at a stoplight.

Turn left at this light, and right over the bridge to

your right "

New Super Buffet (chinese) 2945 Millbranch (right beside the Ramada). Cross Airways at the stoplight, and stay in the right-hand lane to follow the sign for Airways NORTH. When you get back onto the road, move to the middle lane. Just past the overpasses for the interstate is a light at Ketchum & Airways.

To the right on Ketchum is a little burger and ice cream place, Dixie Queen.

Just through the light is a Shell station with SUB-WAY inside. Across the street from Shell is a Church's Chicken.

There are only 2 places I saw that are within walking distance. Just behind Holiday Inn on Airways I saw a sign for Jazz Café (I have no idea what kind of food). And there's Catfish Cabin on Airways.

And ask any of the staff (who are mostly local) if they can give you directions to anything else! If you get back on the interstate, 240 heading west (downtown), then hit 55 south.

The Horn Lake exit has some really good restaurants whether you go right or left. It's a much safer neighborhood. And you can get there in about 10 minutes. But they have started working on 55 at Goodman Road, and I was afraid the traffic would be 1 lane.

In this area, go with a friend.
