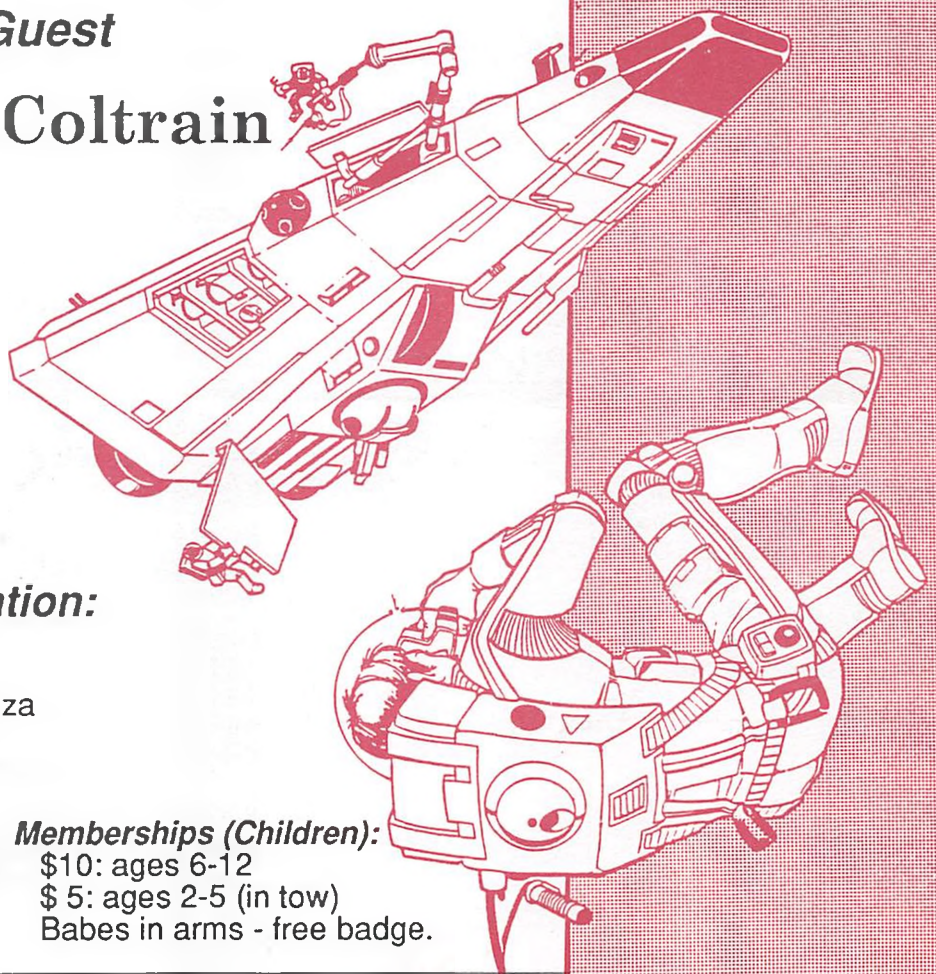

From 1989 to 1992 WSFA Press has published a book for each Disclave Guest of Honor. Our first title, Lucius Shepard's *The Father of Stones*, is now out of print. The stock for the Mike Resnick book is very low - you have been warned!

● Pat Cadigan's **HOME BY THE SEA** was the 1992 Disclave Guest of Honor book. This, her first collection since the highly acclaimed **PATTERNS** (Ursus, 1989), was published in a limited edition of 500 signed, numbered, and slipcased copies. Since publication less than 150 remain.

The book contains four stories (Home By The Sea, Dirty Work, Dispatches From The Revolution, and Fifty Ways To Improve Your Orgasm) totalling over 40,000 words, an author's introduction for each story, a complete bibliography prepared by the author; a foreword by Mike Resnick; and biographical data.

HOME BY THE SEA is the same format as previous WSFA Press books: Lucius Shepard's **THE FATHER OF STONES** and Lewis Shiner's **THE EDGES OF THINGS**. It features 60# Glatfelter acid-free paper; colophons; three-piece two-color cases, Smythe-sewn bindings; spine headers and footers; and thumb-notched slipcases. Artwork includes full-color illustrated endpapers, and full-color tipped-in interiors. Full Library of Congress cataloging information is included. List Price: \$65.00
