3. The Cathedral Basilica of the Assumption 1140 Madison Avenue, Covington, KY. The 67' by 24' stain glass window is the second largest built in the world. The largest was destroyed during the World War II.
4. Chocolate Orgy downtown Plaza 600. A stencil of the galaxy surrounds this flourless concoction, the size of a cupcake, crowned with fried chocolate truffle on blackberry coulis. To die for.
5. Krohn Conservatory in Eden Park 1501 Eden Park Dr. Flowers, plants and trees from around the world. Excellent orchid display. While there, a look at the river would be the thing to do.
