DIRECTIONS

From Buffalo: Take I-190 North across Grand Island. Take exit 21 (Robert Moses Pkwy). This exit starts on the bridge leaving Grand Island. Stay right and follow signs to Robert Moses Pkwy, NY St. Park, American Falls. Exit at 4th Street. Go straight to Rainbow Blvd, then turn left and follow Rainbow Blvd. all the way to Main St. The hotel is on the left at the intersection, with Denny's.

From Canada: Take your best route to the Rainbow Bridge. The hotel is right by the bridge, in the triangular region bounded by Main St., Niagara St., and Rainbow Blvd.

[PS: Don't confuse Main St. with Old Main.]

Our 2009 GUESTS OF HONOR

Vernor Vinge

He has won Hugo Awards for his novels **A Fire Upon the Deep**, **A Deepness in the Sky**, and **Rainbow's End**, and for the novella *Fast Times at Fairmont High*. Known for his rigorous hard-science approach to science fiction, he became an iconic figure among cybernetic scientists in 1981 with the publication of the novella *True Names*, one of the first stories to present a fully fleshed-out concept of cyberspace.

John-Allen Price

His books include **Doomsday Ship**, **Operation Night Hawk**, **Extinction Cruise**, **A Mission For Eagles**, **The Pursuit of The Phoenix**, **The Siege of Ocean Valkyrie**, and **Phoenix Caged**.

His first SF novel, **Mutant Chronicles II: Frenzy**, was published in 1994. He has since completed work on a hard SF military adventure, **Sail a Distant Sea**, and is currently working on outlines/proposals for a cruise ship techno-thriller, a W.W. I alternative history, and another alternative history set in the 1930s.
