## DIRECTIONS

**From Buffalo:** Take I-190 North across Grand Island. Take exit 21 (R. Moses Pkwy). This exit starts on the bridge leaving Grand Island. Stay right and follow signs to Robert Moses Pkwy. NY St. Park, American Falls. Exit at 4th Street. Go straight to Rainbow Blvd. then turn left and follow it all the way to Main St. The hotel is on the left at the intersection, next to the Denny's.

**From Canada:** Take your best route to Rainbow Bridge. The hotel is right by the bridge, in the triangular region bounded by Main St., Niagara St., and Rainbow Blvd.

Minnesota writer Stephen Brust has done about nineteen novels, including the *Vlad Taltos* series, the *Phoenix Guards* series, as well as such books as **To Reign in Hell, Brokedown Palace, The Sun the Moon and the Stars, Cowboy Feng's Space Bar and Grille, The Gypsy, Agyar** (with Megan Lindholm), & **Sethra Lavode**. ### James Alan Gardner

James Alan Gardner lives in Kitchener, Ontario, with his wife, Linda Carson, and two rabbits who hate each other.
