The New York In '89 Guide
to restaurants and services in the Neighborhood
of the Sheraton Hasbrouck Heights Hotel

This guide is divided in sections depending on the direction to be travelled. In all but one case (78 - Marbella) the greatest distance is no more than 2 to 3 miles. Most, however, are at least a mile.

In the Hotels:

- Lobby (ground floor) - Terrace Cafe - Typical hotel coffee shop. can eat for \$5 to \$10. Above average quality, above average prices. acceptable - recommended if (and only if) you don't want to leave the hotel.
- Plaza level - Sports Bar - no food, typical hotel bar, expensive, loud and trendy.
- Penthouse - Appollo - Italian restaurant, can eat for \$11-20. Traditional plastic upscale restaurant. Closed Sun, dinner hours only Sat. Acceptable but slow service.

- North on Polifly Rd. (under I-80) This is the road the hotel is on.
- 83 - Sea Shack - across the street from the hotel. Can eat for \$10-15. Fri 11:30 - 10:30, Sat 4:30 - 11, Sun 1 - 9:30. Takes reservations for 4 or more. Dress casual but neat.
 - 84 - Stony Hill Inn (just past I - 80 on left)
Lunch Fri and Sat 11:30 - 5. can eat for \$6-16
Dinner Fri and Sat 5:30 - 10:30. can eat for \$10-16
reservations suggested, sports jacket required, but not tie jeans and sneakers not permitted.

- North on Polifly Rd to second light, turn left on Essex St. (in Hackensack, in order from Polifly, proceeding westward)
- 8 - Arena Diner - open 24 hours. Can eat for \$4-10 (250 Essex, on corner, Essex and Polifly) HIGHLY RECOMMENDED
 - 9 - Simple Simon Deli - open 24 hours
 - 10 - Essex Cafe Bar
 - 11 - Essex Pawnall Drug store
 - 12 - Coin-op Laundry
 - 13 - Hilltop Luncheonette
 - 14 - O'Meals Bar
 - 15 - Vinnie's Pizza, 364 Essex
 - 16 - Hilltop Food Market
 - 17 - Dairy Queen, 499 Essex
 - 18 - Jodi's, 515 Essex - seafood diner
 - 19 - Dunkin Donuts, 180 Essex, Lodi (in Maywood, by Hackensack border)
 - 20 - Hunan - Chinese take out or eat in. Hot and spicy. can eat for \$3-10. Food very good, service above average, 125 Essex. HIGHLY RECOMMENDED
- (In Lodi, proceeding westward)
- 21 - Triboro Pizza
 - 22 - Carvel
 - 23 - Chicken Holiday, 332 Essex, in Slipperstein's Shopping Center
Chicken, seafood and ribs take out

- 45 - New Star Diner, 480 Phillips Ave, S. Hack. - poor
 - 46 - Mofetas, 370 US 46, S. Hack. - Greek, with entertainment. Good, expensive. Can eat for \$20-25.
- South on Terrace to US Route 46, Right (westbound) on Route 46
- 47 - Peking Pagoda. Eat in and take out.
Fri and Sat 11:30-12:30. Sat luncheon special can eat for \$4-6
Sun 12-11. Normally can eat for \$4-8. can eat well up to \$11.
usually packed. Has good reputation.
- South on Terrace to Route 17, North (Left) on Route 17.
(Note - you can get to the A & P on Essex St. this way, but it is not recommended due to traffic.)
- 48 - Crow's Nest - bar and restaurant, good and reasonable.
- South on Terrace to Route 17, South (Right) on Route 17.
- 49 - Bendix Diner, at Williams St. - NOT recommended.
 - 50 - Shop Rite Food Market - the closest shopping to the hotel
 - 51 - Liquor store - in the Shop Rite Center
 - 52 - Laundromat - in the Shop Rite Center
 - 53 - Sundry shop
 - 54 - Dunkin Donuts, 343 Rt 17
 - 55 - Mc Donald's, 329 Rt 17 - one of the better ones
 - 56 - Janathans in the Quality Motor Inn, 283 Rt 17 - seafood, good.
 - 57 - Cosmo Diner, at Franklin St. - NOT Recommended.
 - 58 - Mt. Fuji Japanese Steak House
Good food, High Price, good service
 - 59 - Dairy Queen, 187 Rt 17 - Below average
 - 60 - Kentucky Fried Chicken
 - 61 - Fat Mike's - RANK greasy Spoon
 - 62 - Ground Round - Typical
 - 63 - Int'l House of Pancakes, 111 Rt 17 - Typical
 - 64 - White Castle - 24 Hours
- (on the other side of Route 17, (Northbound) in Woodbridge)
- 65 - The Derby Diner, 707 Rt 17
- (on the other side of Route 17, (Northbound) in Carlstadt)
- 66 - El Viquilo - expensive, good, very tasty
 - 67 - Steve's Sizzling Steaks
 - 68 - Hot Dog House
 - 69 - North American Lobster House, 410 Rt 46, Crist. - clam bar
 - 70 - Meadowlands Diner, 320 Rt 17, Crist. - DON'T EAT HERE
- (off Route 17)
- 71 - Mr. Lucky's, 295 Hoboken Rd, Crist. - bar, plenty food.
 - 72 - Coy's aka Caughy's - 64 Hoboken Rd, E. Rutherford
Overhead.
- (back on Route 17)
- 73 - Dick O'Leary's, 185 Rt 17 - Irish bar and restaurant - very good.
 - 74 - Rutherford House - 71 Union ave, E. Rutherford
(can be seen from route 17, on right)
Fri 11-11, Sat 12-11, Sun 1-9
Dinner style for lunch. can eat for under \$7
Seafood and Italian restaurant for dinner, can eat for \$6-10
can eat well for \$15. Innovative chef.
HIGHLY RECOMMENDED.
 - 75 - Roy Rogers

- 24 - Quick Check food store, in Slipperstein's Shopping Center
 - 25 - Fish Takeout, in Slipperstein's Shopping Cent. - closed Sunday
 - 26 - Chinese Takeout, in Slipperstein's Shopping Center - good reputation, fast food.
 - 27 - Cafe - bar, can eat for \$1-7, eat well for \$10, must be at least 21 years old and properly attired.
 - 28 - A and P food store - 24 hour, beer and liquor until 1am at intersection with Route 17, but there is lots of traffic
 - 29 - Nathans Hot Dogs - rank (and we don't mean top) (in Rochelle Park, just over Lodi line)
 - 30 - Rusty Nail - bar, kitchen open to 1 am, can eat for \$2-5 good food, nice bar (Brian's favorite bar in all New Jersey)
- North on Polifly Rd to second light, turn right on Essex St.
- 31 - The Player's Club (40 Essex, S.E. corner of Essex and Polifly) disco, good food, open 7 days
 - 32 - Mr. Special's Deli
 - 33 - HoHo Chinese - NOT Recommended
 - 34 - Roy Rogers, 193 Essex - classic Triggerburgers

- From Essex east of Polifly (above) Turn right on State St.
- 35 - San Marco Luncheonette and Deli, 108 S. State, Hackensack, open 6-9, closed Sunday.
Recommended, but under new management, so something might have changed. Good coffee.
 - 36 - Tap Room, 211 Huyler, S. Hack. - Recommended, but check hours
 - 37 - King of Pizza, Also sandwiches and seafood.
NOT Recommended. Send your enemies.
 - 38 - The Greenhouse - 310 Huyler, S. Hackensack
Bar and semi-good restaurant. Fri and Sat.

- Pathmark Shopping Center (Southbound on Route 17, North of hotel)
Take Route 17 North to Summit Ave East (left lane), left turn top of ramp, right turn (first light)
- 1 - Pathmark (including pharmacy: Fri 9-9, Sat. 9-6, Sun 10-2)
 - 2 - Bottle King Liquor - Keg and bottle beer
 - 3 - Roy Rogers - (411 rt 17) "Triggerburgers", good cole slaw
 - 4 - Baskin Robins
 - 5 - Mr. Pizza - possible, not recommended

- South (left) on Terrace Ave (also known as Polifly Rd when going North)
- 79 - The Old Homestead, 307 Terrace - can eat for \$6-15
 - 80 - 7-11 convenience store
 - 81 - Jahan's Liquor and Deli
 - 82 - Boca Wine and Liquor - Hackensack Ave in Woodridgs.

- South on Terrace to US Route 46, Left (eastbound) on Route 46
- 39 - Burger King, 490 US 46, S. Hack.
 - 40 - Dunkin Donuts, 429 US 46, Little Ferry
 - 41 - 2 Scuzzi GoGo joints (New Jersey has everything)
 - 42 - Wendy's, 410 US 46, S. Hack.
 - 43 - HerJoy's Corner - luncheonette, hot dogs, eggs, sausage.
Fast, good, recommended.
 - 44 - Sichuan Taste, 388 US 46, S. Hack. - reputed to be so-so.

- 76 - Burger King
- 77 - The Mexican Place - Meadow Rd. off Rt. 17. Fast food, Recommended, (continuing into Lyndhurst, South on Ridge Road (not on map))
- 78 - Marbella - Spanish and seafood.
Luncheon specials from \$4-9, dinners up to \$15
Good food, large portions, good service.
Long drive, but worth it. HIGHLY Recommended.

Going South on Boulevard in Hasbrouck Heights Center, Just before and after Williams.

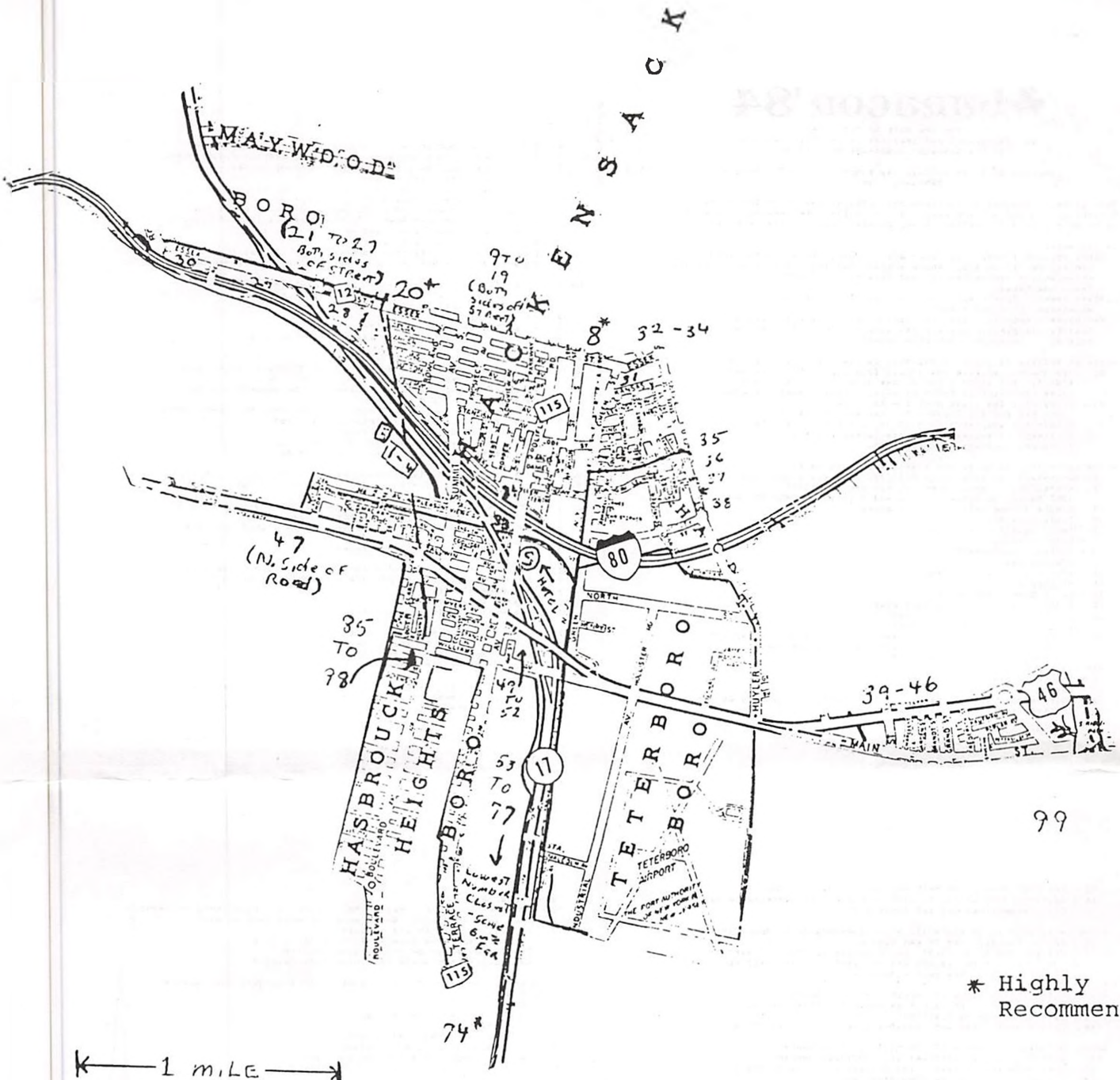
