FHC will hold an official meeting of the Society for the Preservation of the History of Science Fiction Fandom: The Timebinders. The program will include a celebration of MWC's origins and the myths and events it has contributed to fanlore. Otherwise, it's the same MWC with its well-stocked con suite and a small but quality huckster room, featuring both new and used books.

Midwestcon is known as the Relaxacon because of its total emphasis on parties, smoffing, and personal interaction rather than formal programming. Over the years at Midwestcon marriages and reputations have been made; Worldcons and card games have been won and lost. How many small regional cons besides Midwestcon can say that their last convention had 7 past Worldcon Fan GoHs, 4 past Worldcon Toastmasters, 7 past or future Worldcon Chairpersons, 6 past DUFF delegates, and several pro and fan Hugo nominees and winners.

DIRECTIONS



From the West: Take I-70 East to I-75. Then follow the directions for "From the North."

From the South: Take I-71 North to exit 15. Turn West on Pfeiffer Road.

The hotel is located to your immediate left (at the BP Gas Station & Bob Evans). Turn left to 5901 Pfeiffer Road.



SATURDAY MORNING BRUNCH. Due to its success the past two years, we will again have a "Country Breakfast" buffet in place of our Saturday night banquet.
