

Check-in time is normally 3 pm, though you can check in earlier if rooms are ready. Check-out time is 1 pm everyday. Checkout time will be extended on Sunday April 19, 1981 to 5 pm. For this one day only.

How to get to the hotel

From highways to the west (including I-94) take 94 to Highway 12. Head downtown and take the Hawthorne Avenue exit. From Hawthorne turn right onto N. 10th Street, following the few jogs it takes to become S. 10th St., and turning left onto Marquette, and left again on S.7th St. to the Radisson Hotel or the parking ramp of your choice. (See the map.)

On I-94 from the east, take the 11th St exit, following 11th until you turn

right onto Marquette, a left to S. 7th St., and a quick left jab into the Solar Plexis of the Radisson!

I-35 from the south is an Instant Replay of the above paragraph.

I-35 from the north requires taking the 11th Avenue exit; at the top of the ramp, take 11th Avenue to the right, and then take a left onto South 7th St. This should take you to the Radisson. (Take care: the street numbering on 11th Ave. jumps from 14th to 8th.)

The bus depot is 4 blocks from the hotel, one block northwest of Hennepin Ave. on N. 9th St. The Amtrak railway depot is in the Midway District between Minneapolis and St. Paul. Taxi Service is available.

The Twin City International Airport has bus, limousine and taxi service.

The art show goes on as normal and the rates will be similar to last year. 50¢ for each item. The sketch table is free for items that are less than \$15.


Our commission is 15% on items and 10% for the sketch table.

Reproduction


