We look forward to seeing you.

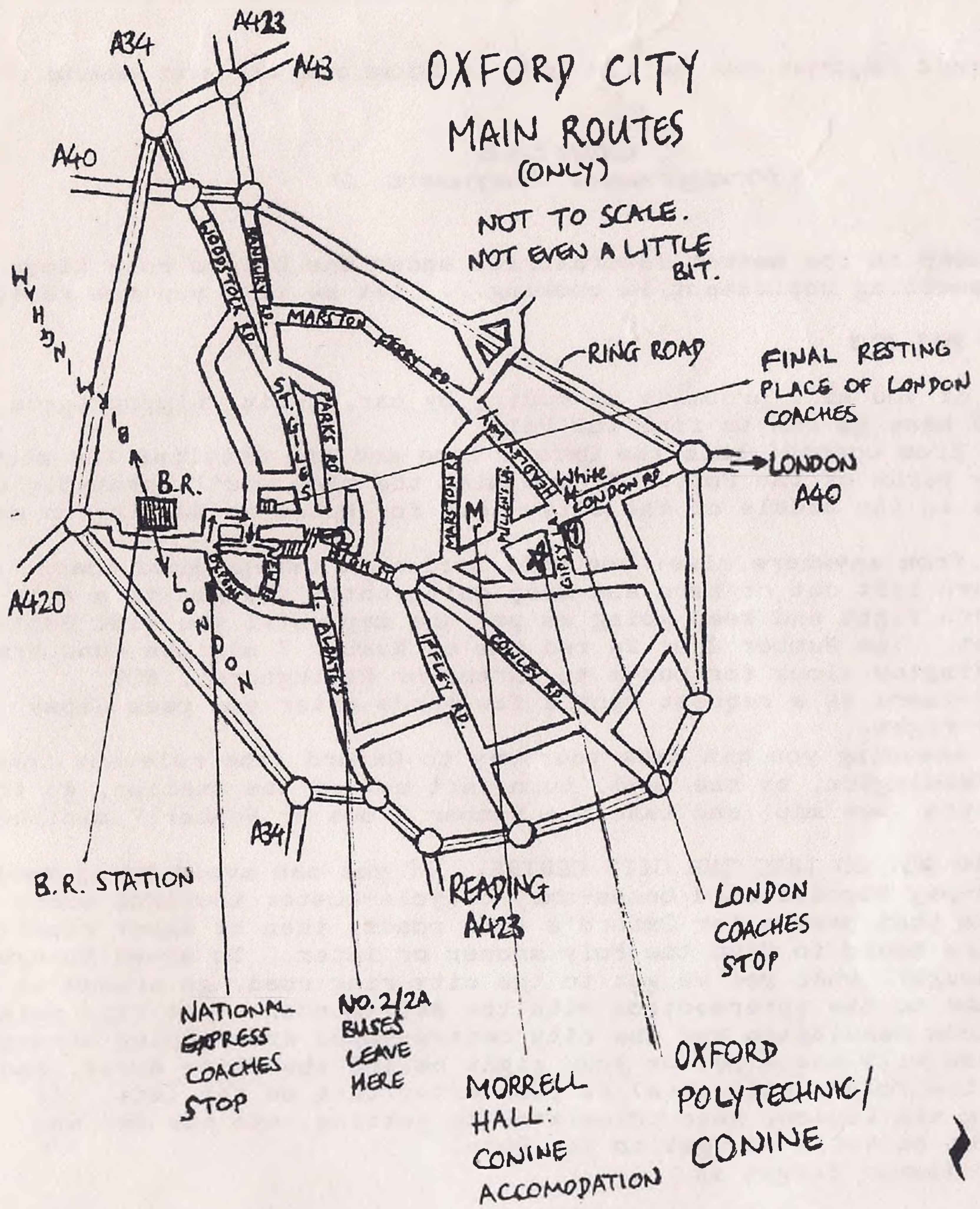

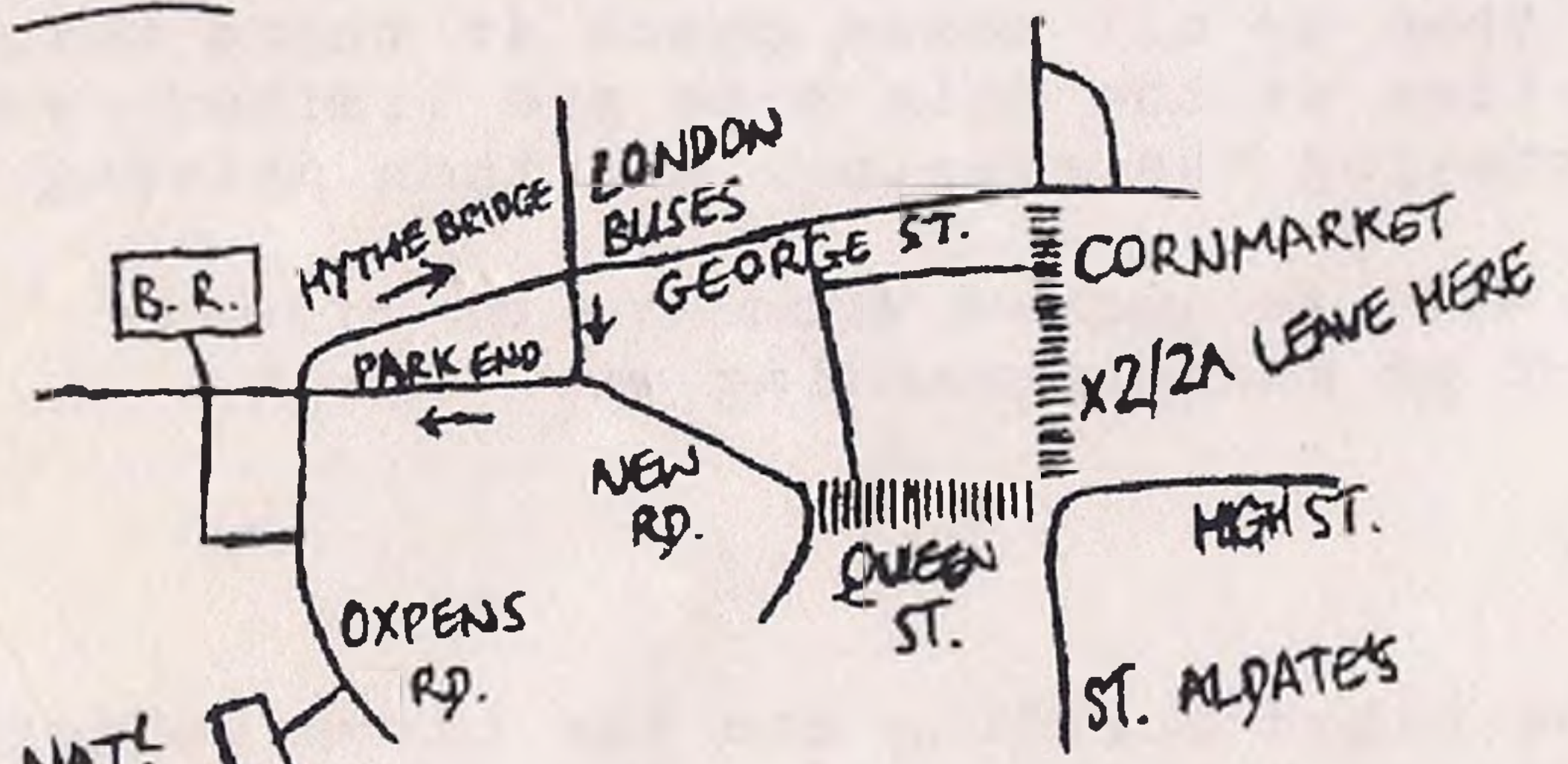
