was founded in 1965 to "inform science fiction writers on matters of professional interest, to promote their professional welfare, and to help them deal effectively with publishers, agents, editors and anthologists." The first Nebula Awards banquets were held in New York and Los Angeles in 1966. *Nebula Award Stories 1965*, the first of a series of annual anthologies sponsored by SFWA, was published by Doubleday in the same year. In its four years, SFWA's original membership of 78 has grown to 325, extending its services and membership to authors, published in the United States, residing in Great Britain, Ireland, Ceylon, Australia, Mexico, Canada, British Honduras and Libya.
