


New Artist Guest of Honor!

We are excited to announce that Grace P. Fong will be the Norwescon 45 Artist Guest of Honor. Grace is a Chinese-American illustrator whose artwork has appeared in *Uncanny Magazine*, *Strange Horizons*, and other speculative fiction anthologies. She has been nominated four times for the Best Fan Artist Hugo Award, and won the inaugural Ignyte Award in 2020. She uses her experience as a narrative designer in tabletop/trading card games (*Magic: the Gathering*) and video gaming (*Palia*) to inform and educate writers and artists how to work together.


Norwescon 45 Announces COVID Policy
