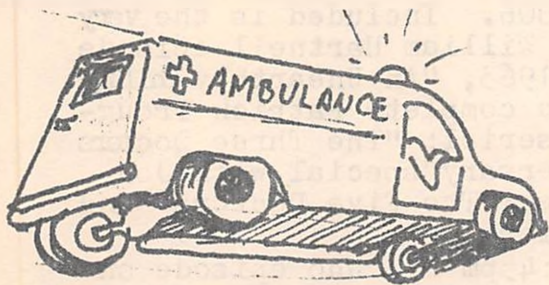

MASQUERADE TO START AT 10:00!

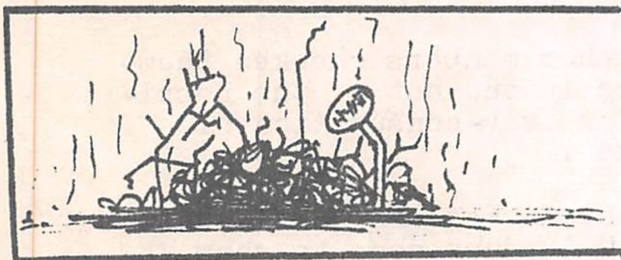

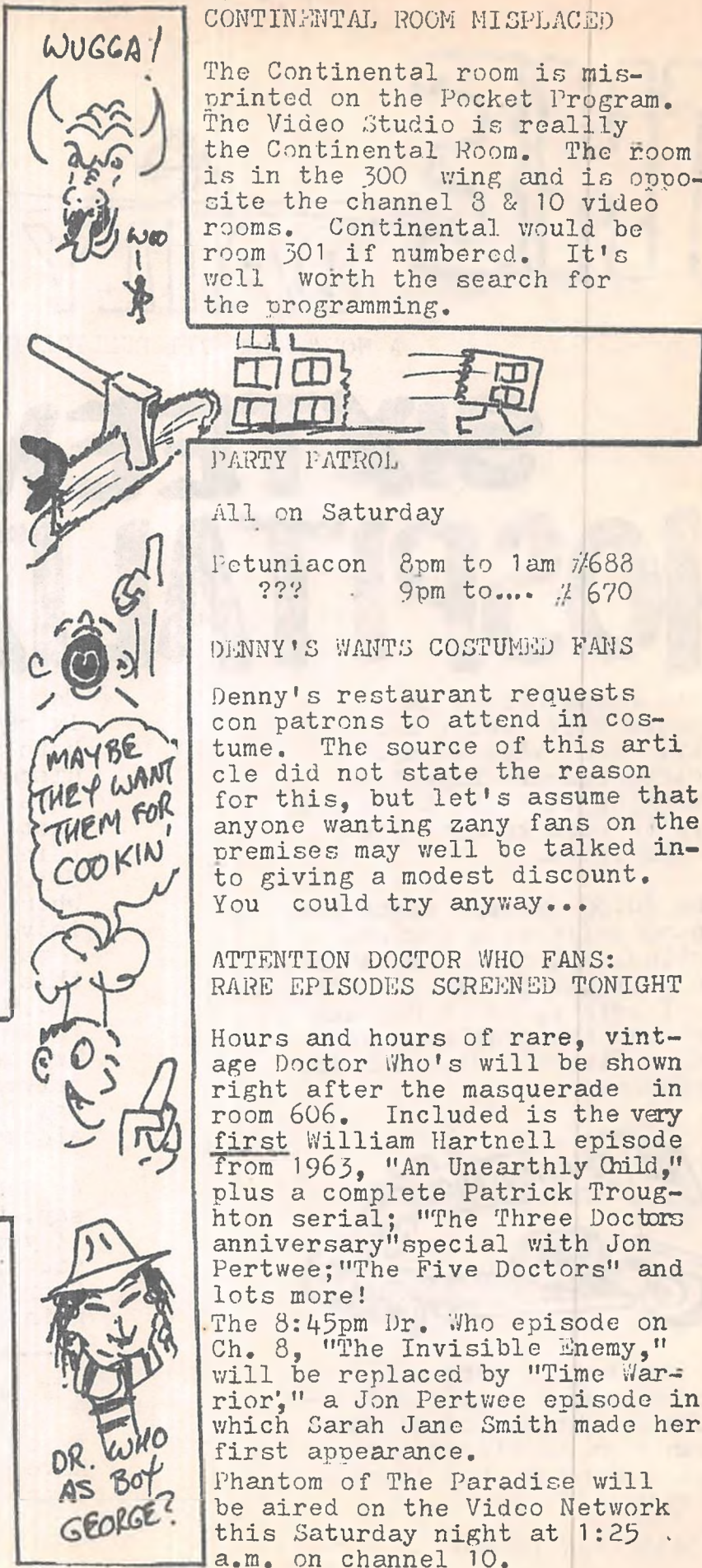
HOTEL WARNS OF FIRE
