1) Leave the M6 at the junction for 'Birmingham (Central)'. This is the famous 'Spaghetti Junction'


2) You will now be on the Aston Expressway heading for the City Centre.

4) At the end of the flyover, keep to the left - do not go under the

tunnel, (Point 'B' on map).

5) THE ROYAL ANGUS HOTEL is a few yards past Point 'B' and the entrance to the car park is at the far end of the hotel.

If you are travelling by rail or by coach, you will arrive at New Street Station. At the front of the Station (Point 'C') you will be able to catch the 101 bus (City Circular Shoppers Special). This runs every five minutes (but only up to 6pm) and has a standard fare of 2p irrespective of distance travelled. Ask to be put off at the Post & Mail Building (Point 'D'). From this point it is a short walk back to the hotel.

On arrival at the hotel, please book in at the reception desk on the ground floor. The Con registration desk will be set up outside the lift area on the second floor (please note that at this hotel the ground floor is the first floor!). At the registration desk you will be able to get your programme booklet, Con badge (please wear this at all times), banquet tickets, etc. The entrance fee is £2 (your original 75p registration fee will be deducted from this).

Banquet tickets are still available at £3.25 each. Please see Pauline Dungate or whoever is on the registration desk for these.
