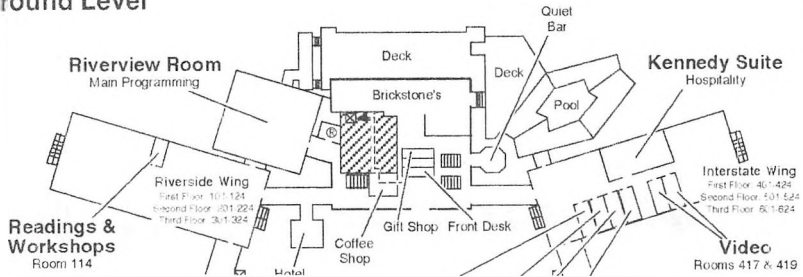

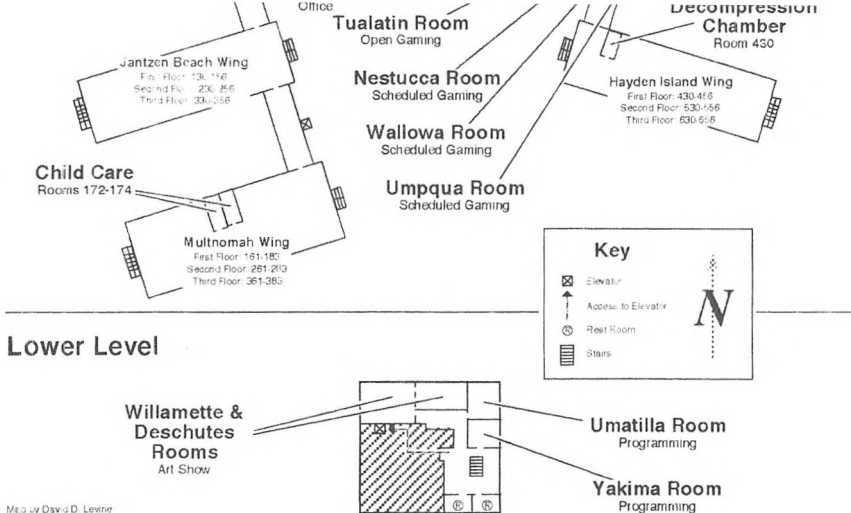

Restaurant and Services Guide

Welcome to Hayden Island, in the Columbia River. Any restaurant or store on the island is within walking distance for most (under 1/2 mile), but walk carefully; it's tricky for both pedestrians and cars. People with children might want to drive to island locations for safety's sake.

The only road off the island is I-5. Go South and you'll head into Portland. North on I-5 will take you over the bridge into Washington and the city of Vancouver. If you're short for time, stay on the island.

We recommend that you make reservations for any restaurant that isn't fast-food, pizza, or a Denny's clone, especially if you have a large group. Phone numbers are all local Oregon numbers unless specified.

Listings are grouped as follows: The hotel; the mall; other places West of I-5 on the island; places East of I-5; and "services" — bank machines, groceries, etc. Numbers in the margin refer to the area map on page 41.

Restaurants between here and Downtown Portland, 7 miles south, don't cluster around the freeway, though there are some more highway-style places one exit south of the Island at Delta Park. For someplace special, you'll have to range a little farther afield. Northwest, Southwest (including downtown), and Southeast Portland have most of the restaurants favored by the committee. We're unfamiliar with the Vancouver restaurant scene, but would love to hear of any good places you might find. Drop by the Fanzine Room and check out the Portland Oregonian and Willamette Week restaurant guides (with margin comments by ye ed.), and the Vancouver Visitor's Bureau Dining Guide. There's also a Portland map to help you find the place you seek. We *highly* recommend calling ahead to verify that the restaurant of your choice is open and can take you.

In the Red Lion

In the hotel:

Brickstones Bar

Sun-Thu 11:30-Midnight, Fri-Sat 11:30-2:00

A significant food menu is available in the bar from 11:30 to 10pm, and seating may be available when Brickstones is full. There are plenty of TVs, smoking is permitted, and the music is loud, so a meal here may not be to everyone's taste.

Brickstones Restaurant

Lunch: Mon-Fri 11:30-2:00; Brunch: Sun 8:00-1:30;

Dinner: Fri-Sat 5-11, Sun-Thurs 5-10.

Service can be slow and prices a bit high, but the food is good. We suggest making reservations. Sunday brunch (9:30-1:30) is \$9.50 for the buffet, and you can add items from the menu.

Red Lion Coffee Garden

Out in the middle of the lobby, the coffee shop is the ideal place to see and be seen. They have agreed to stay open extended hours for the con—6am to 1am Friday and Saturday; 6am to 8pm Sunday—but I wouldn't hold my breath.... In case of emergencies, remember, Denny's never closes.

Quiet Bar

Erratic hours, but will be open Sunday afternoon 3-7.

In the lobby near con registration. If you're looking for a place for a drink or conversation, and don't want the tumult of Brickstones, check if this bar is open. This is where the committee and guests can be found on Thursday night after set up.

Jantzen Beach Mall

The restaurants in the mall are the usual mall fare. All the establishments listed for Jantzen Beach Mall are open during standard mall hours: Monday-Friday 10-9; Saturday 10-6; Sunday 11-6.

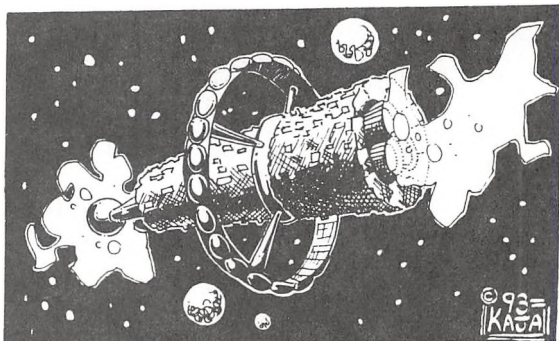
