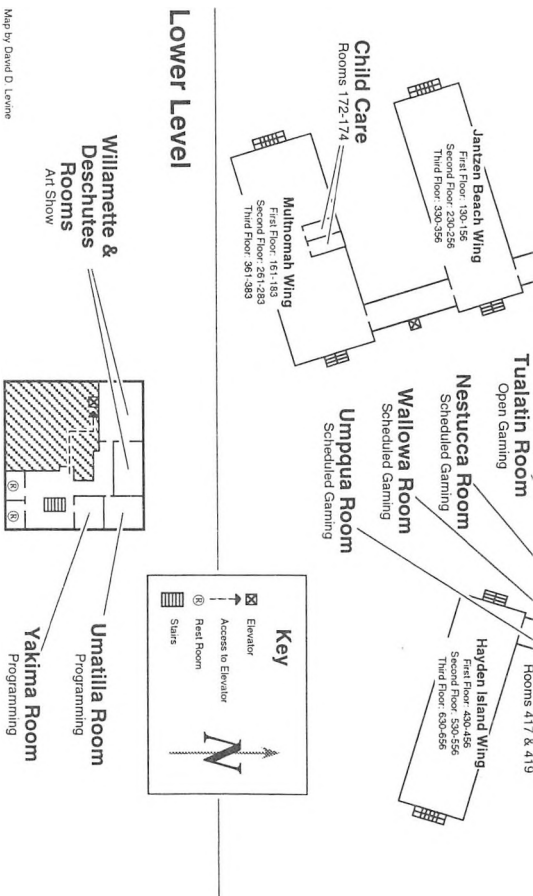

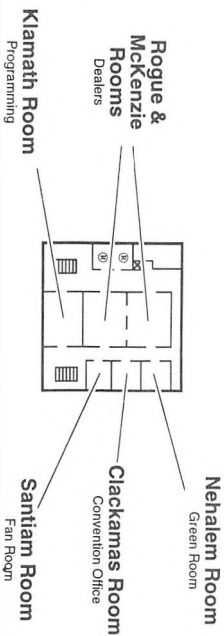

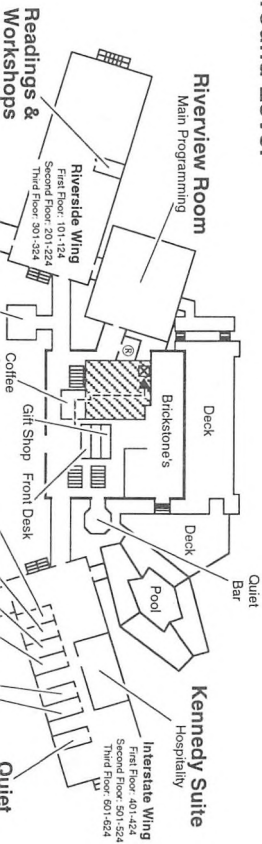

RESTAURANT AND SERVICES GUIDE

Welcome to yet another OryCon weekend at Hayden Island. The Columbia River and Jantzen Beach Shopping Center (JBSC) frame the Red Lion/Columbia (RL/C). Quick access to food, shopping, and a carousel are within walking distance, all accompanied by a challenging experience of dodging cars, trucks and other pedestrians to reach the mall. In other words, watch your step when you go to JBSC, it's still a labyrinthine puzzle to get from here to there.

I-5 is the modern Oregon Trail to Vancouver, Portland and all points beyond. Vancouver is just over the interstate Bridge, and the bulk of Portland lies to the south of the RL/C. There are other access routes to both, but we don't want to get you hopelessly lost during your time here.

Downtown Portland is 7 miles south on I-5, accessible by both car and bus. If you want to spend the bulk of your time at the Con (don't we all), you are slightly in bondage to the Island, but if you are one of those who needs a break, there are a number of food and entertainment offerings for the fannish explorer who wishes to have her/his own adventures.

Remember to make reservations at any restaurant that isn't a fast-food, pizza or Denny's clone. Large groups are welcome at any restaurant with enough notice, but subject to the big hairy eyeball if they show up without warning. There are a number of specialty restaurants in the area, and copies of the Oregonian A & E and the Willamette Week restaurant guides will be available for your perusal. Ask at the Information Desk. The listings included are just suggestions, and the "tip of the iceberg" for local dining and entertainment.

RED LION DINING

There are several Red Lion Inns in the Portland/Vancouver area, and all of them feature opportunities for dining roughly equivalent in format to RL/C. Each has a Coffee Garden for informal dining and also a fine dining facility. If you are one of those folk who reserved your room here with a Visa or MasterCard, you can dine at *any* Red Lion restaurant and charge your food and drink to your room account. Also, if you want to dine at either the Red Lion/Jantzen Beach or the Inn At The Quay (in Vancouver), you can make reservations at the restaurants at either and also reserve the shuttle to take you back and forth between these three Red Lions. You need to give the shuttle service *at least* one hour's notice if you plan to take advantage of these dining Options.

It's also possible (but terribly convoluted) to take the RL/C shuttle to the Airport, then take the RL/Lloyd Center or RL/Downtown shuttle from the airport to either place and repeat the process to come home. It depends on how much time you want to spend at Portland International between shuttles.

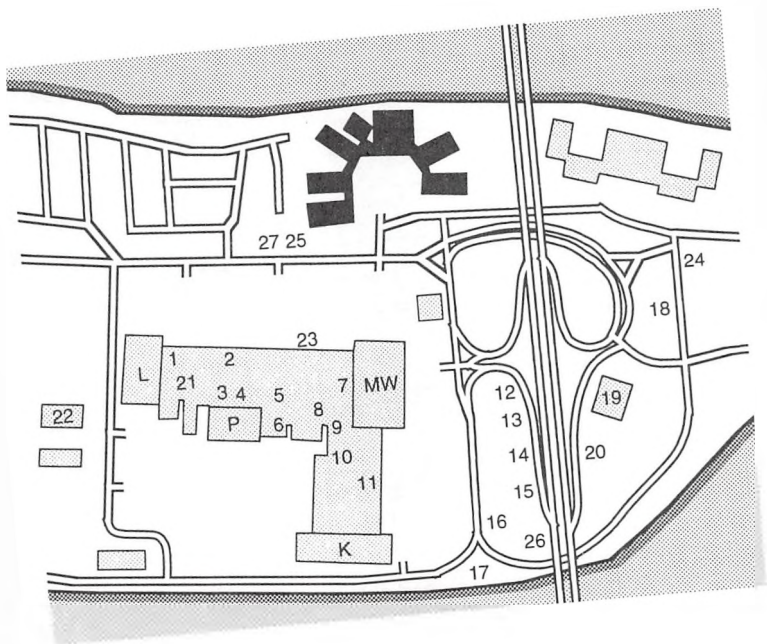
